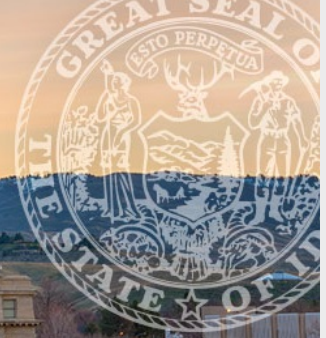

Officials are working with CDC and other states and are also in regular communication with Idaho public health districts and healthcare providers around the state.
