Idaho's response to COVID-19 is now primarily local or regional in nature. The State of Idaho and Governor's Office will continue to monitor statewide COVID-19 activity and work closely with the seven public health districts across the state to ensure the health and safety of Idahoans. Idaho public health officials are monitoring the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19) situation very closely. **Idaho is currently reporting 6,117 confirmed and probable cases** .

Officials are working with CDC and other states and are also in regular communication with Idaho public health districts and healthcare providers around the state.
