

Indiana's Novel Coronavirus Response

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) is closely monitoring a pandemic of the 2019 novel (new) coronavirus or COVID-19. This new respiratory virus was first identified in the city of Wuhan in China's Hubei Province and continues to infect people in China and around the world, including the United States. On March 6, ISDH <u>confirmed</u> the first case of COVID-19 in a Hoosier with recent travel. On March 16, ISDH <u>reported</u> the first death in Indiana due to COVID-19. ISDH is working with federal and local partners, including the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), to respond to this evolving public health situation.




