Q. How often is the map/data updated?

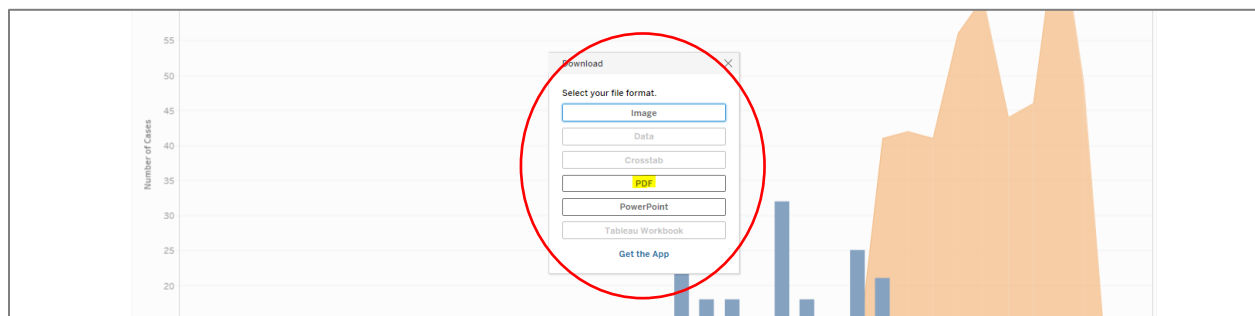
The data is update every day at noon CST.

Q. How can I share the maps/data?

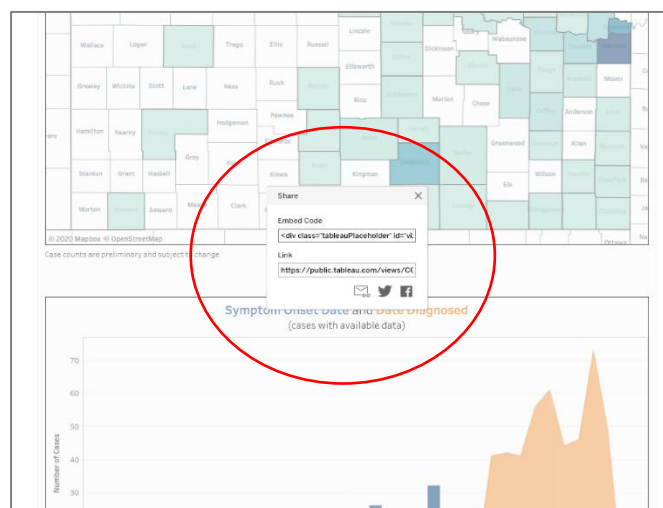
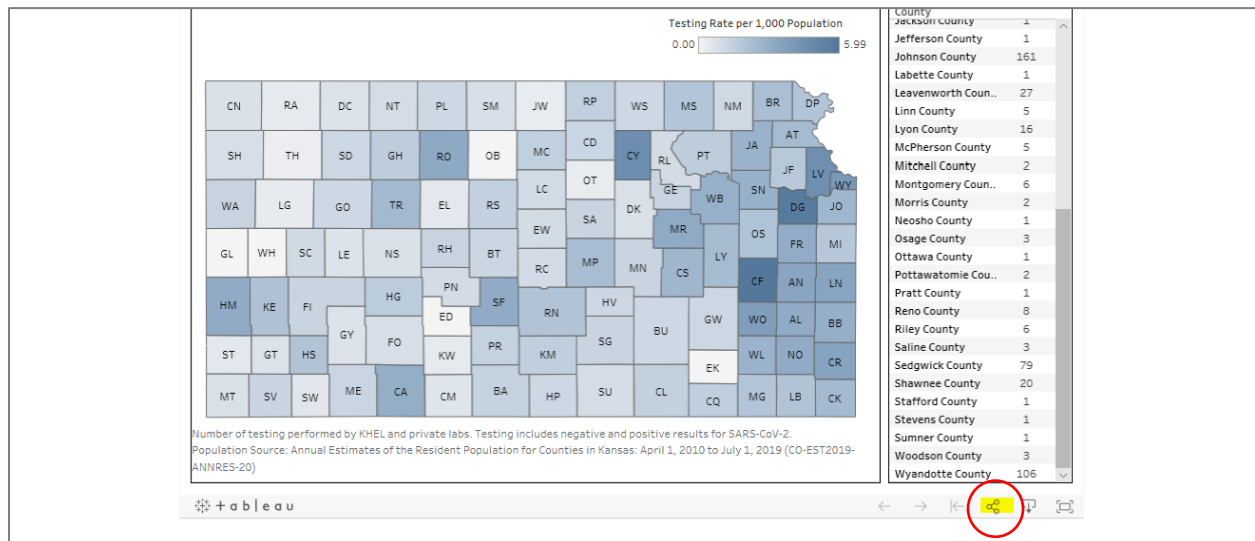
1. Scroll to the bottom of the page and select the metadata you want to work with.
