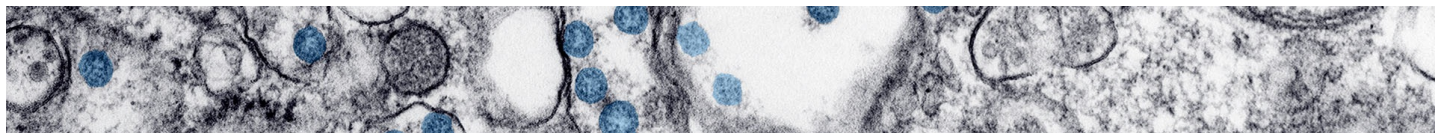

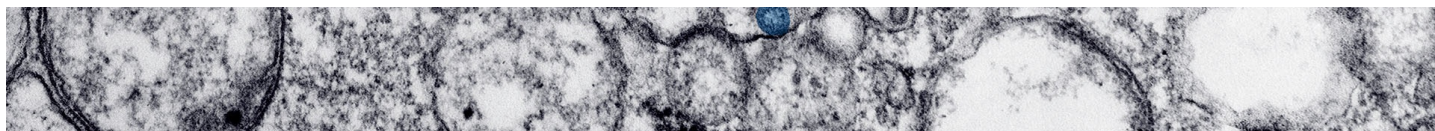
- › State park campgrounds, overnight lodging facilities and shelters are closed, but state parks stay open for now
