

Minnesota Case Information

Not all cases of COVID-19 are tested, so it is not a representative of the total number of people in Minnesota who have or had COVID-19. Number of positive cases is the cases that were tested and returned positive. All data are preliminary and may change as cases are investigated.

- Total positive: 346
 - Patients who no longer need to be isolated: 134
- Total approximate number of completed tests: 12,950
 - Approximate number of completed tests from the MDH Public Health Lab: 6,849
 - Approximate number of completed tests from external laboratories: 6,101
- Deaths: 2
- Total cases requiring hospitalization: 41
 - Hospitalized as of today: 31

Numbers are cumulative since Jan. 20, 2020.

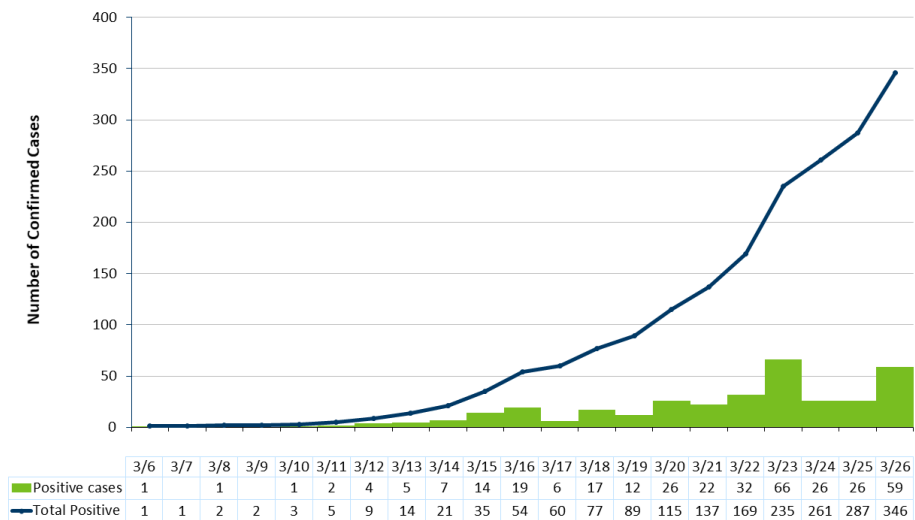


