And are age 65 or older, immunocompromised, live in a long-term care facility, or have been diagnosed with:

- Diabetes
- Heart disease
- Lung disease
- Chronic kidney disease

Please call 402.559.0041 prior to making a clinic appointment, visiting an Immediate Care Clinic or the emergency room. Our staff will provide a screening evaluation and recommend next steps.

If you are younger than age 65, and otherwise healthy, at this time **the best guidance is to stay home** get plenty of rest, drink fluids and take pain and fever medications like acetaminophen or ibuprofen.

If you are not a Nebraska Medicine patient, you are encouraged to call your local primary care provider for guidance.
