

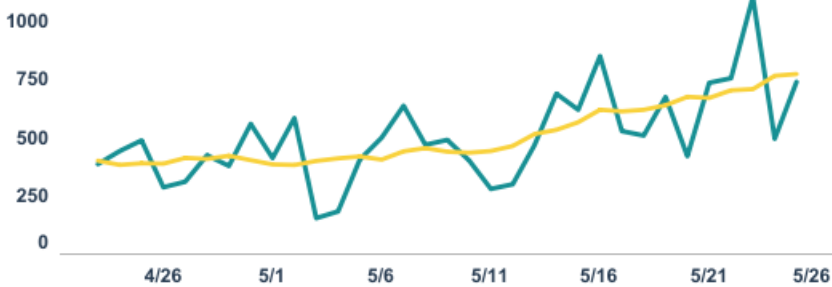


# COVID-19 North Carolina Dashboard

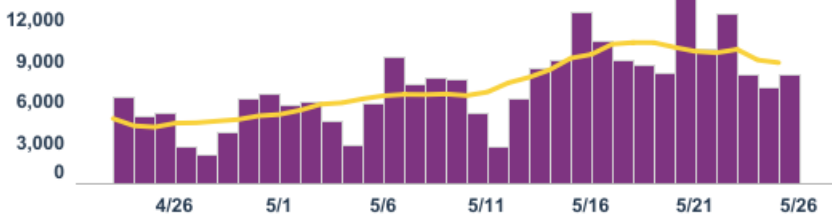
Updated daily by approximately 11 a.m. Last updated May 25, 2020 at 10:55 a.m.

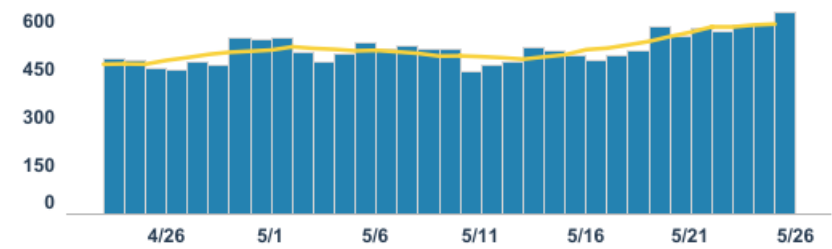
## Daily Cases i



## Daily Tests i

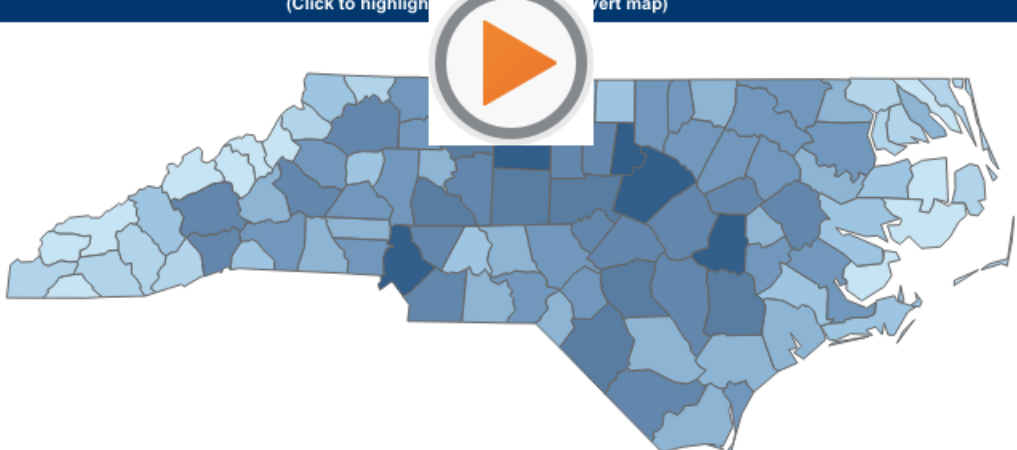


## Daily Number of People Currently Hospitalized i
