Oregon currently has 19 positive cases of COVID-19.

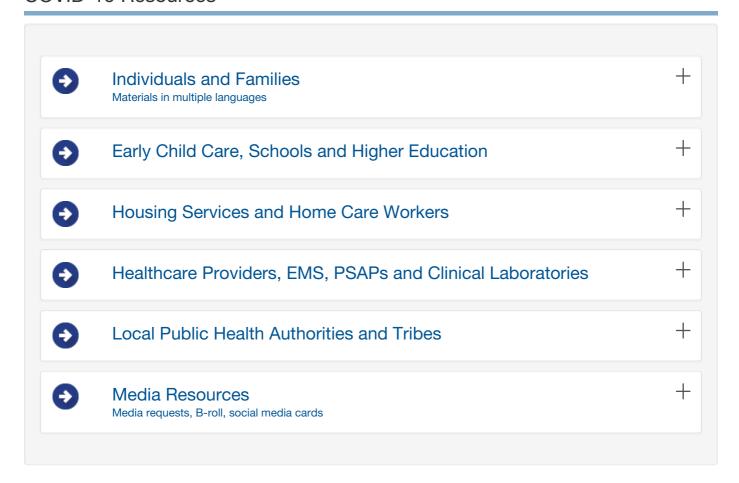

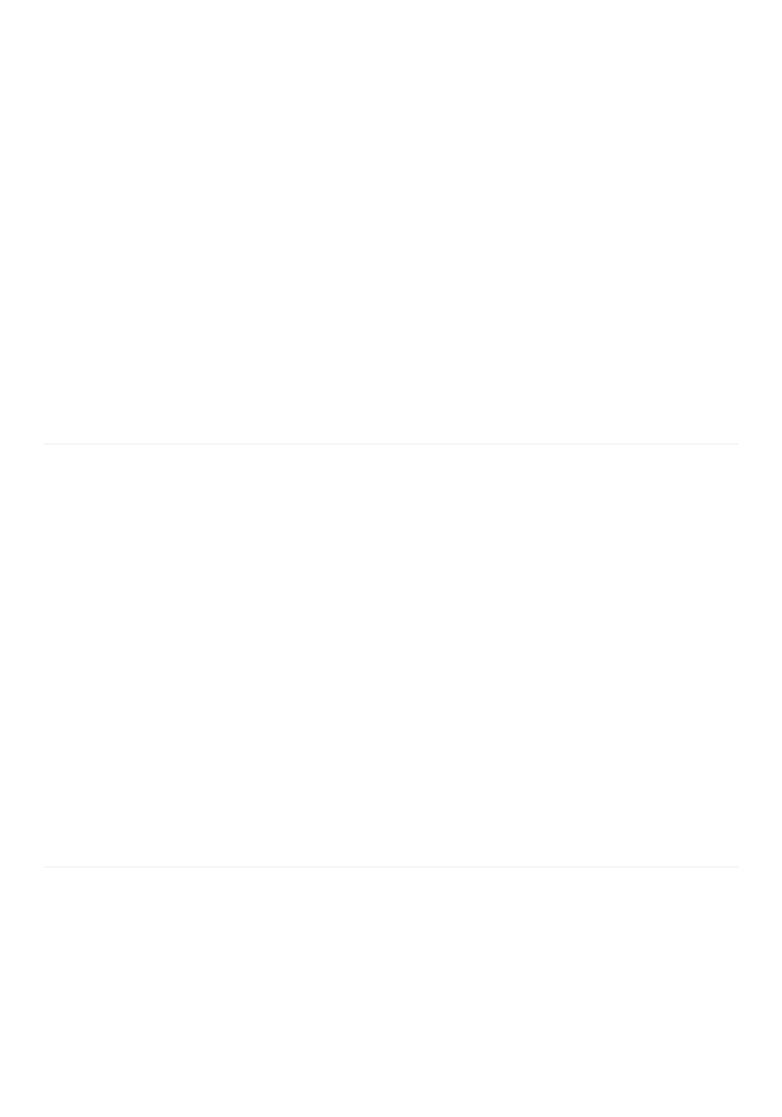
