Current cases: The state has 136 cases total, after 23 new resident and one new visitor case were announced Saturday among the more than 400 new tests. New cases were confirmed in Davis (2), Salt Lake County (13 resident, one visitor), Summit (4), Utah County (1), and Wasatch (3). This is slightly down from the 34 resident cases announced Friday..
