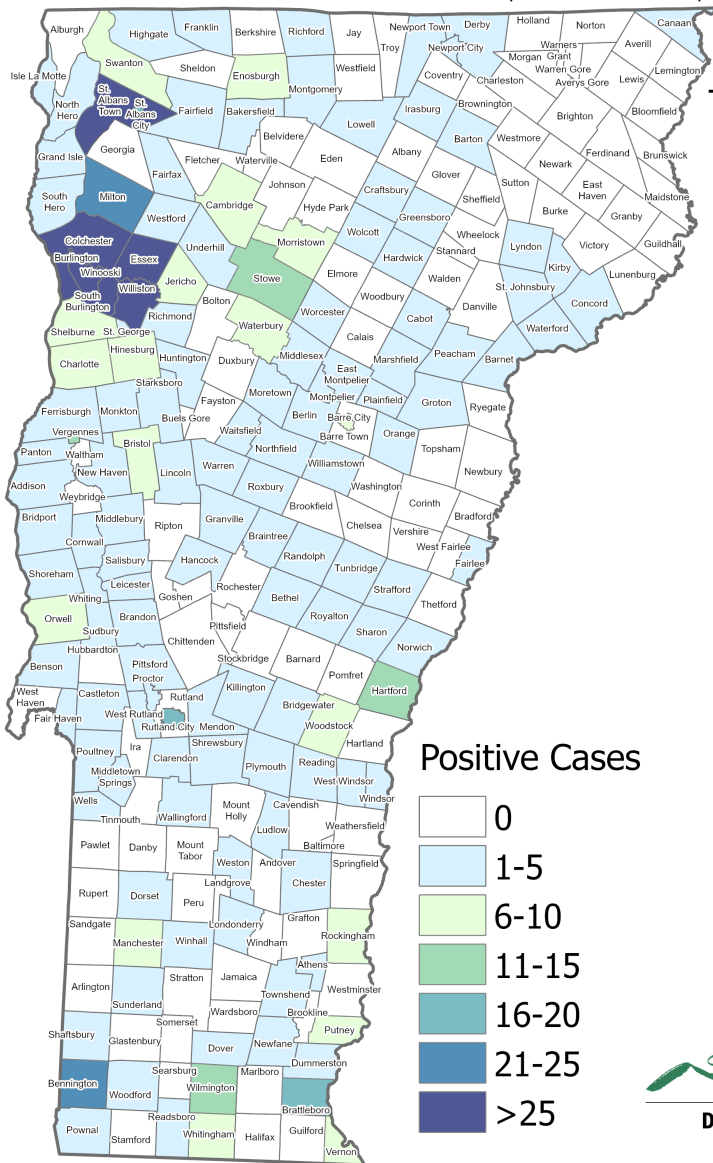
## VERMONTERS WHO HAVE TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 BY TOWN

This data reflects lab-confirmed cases of COVID-19 among Vermont residents, by town of residence. Map is updated weekly.

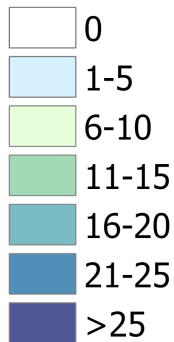
