## Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)



At this time there are no reported cases in Wyoming.

The Wyoming Department of Health is closely monitoring the current coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak situation and sharing recommendations. At this time, the risk to our residents remains low. However, it is likely COVID-19 will spread to this state at some point.

Coronaviruses are a large family of viruses, some of which cause the common cold in people and others that circulate among animals. COVID-19 was first identified in Wuhan, China in

late 2019.

This is a new virus and new viruses need special attention. We don't yet know how easily COVID-19 spreads and how many people will experience severe illness. However, the symptoms reported with this disease are familiar to all of us: fever, cough and shortness of breath. Some of the steps that can help prevent the spread of such illnesses include: avoiding contact with sick people, staying home when sick, covering nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing and washing hands often and carefully.

## Travel Information

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends avoiding all nonessential travel to **China, Iran, Italy and South Korea**. CDC also says older adults and those with chronic medical conditions should consider postponing nonessential travel to **Japan**.

CDC also recommends travelers, particularly those with underlying health issues, avoid all cruise ship travel worldwide at this time.

The Wyoming Public Health Laboratory began COVID-19 testing on March 5. This lab is part of the Wyoming Department of Health. Any testing performed at the Wyoming Public Health Laboratory must be arranged through a healthcare provider and submissions will be screened and approved by our department. Previously, the department was able to request testing at the CDC in Atlanta.
