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1. CURRENT SITUATION UPDATE

- **Country Highlights**: As of 18hrs on 27th March 2020:
 - There were six (6) new confirmed cases (5 in Lusaka and 1 on the Copperbelt) recorded in the past 24 hours. The total number of confirmed cases is twenty-two (22). There have been zero (0) deaths recorded (Refer to Annex 1)
 - Levy Mwanawasa Hospital: There are currently 23 patients admitted at Levy Mwanawasa Hospital in Lusaka: 20 confirmed positive and 3 suspected cases (with results pending)




Figure 1: Map of Zambia showing confirmed COVID-19 cases by province as of 27th March 2020







2. ACTIONS TO DATE

2.1 CO-ORDINATION

- Policy Level: Government measures and interventions to control the spread of COVID-19 came into effect at midnight on Thursday 26th March, 2020. The measures include continued screening of travellers into Zambia (symptomatic travellers will be isolated at a health facility; asymptomatic travellers are required to undergo quarantine at their own cost and monitoring for at least 14 days); redirection of all international flights to land and depart from KKIA only; suspension of non-essential travel to countries with confirmed COVID-19 cases; restriction of public gatherings to no more than 50 people; restaurants to operate only on take away and delivery basis; and closure of all bars, nightclubs, cinemas, gyms and casinos.
- ➤ **Technical level:** The IMS continues to meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays. (Refer to Annex 2 for the IMS structure)

2.2 SURVEILLANCE

- ➤ POE, health facility, sentinel site and Event Based Surveillance: surveillance data is being collected from all these sites and remains heightened country wide.
 - The number of cases reported country-wide is summarised in the table 2 below
 - Standard case definitions are being used (Refer to Annex 3).

Laboratory:

- Total samples received to date is 350, 269 results processed with 22 confirmed positive. Summary
 of tests conducted to date is available in Annex1
- **Case Management:** Refer to Annex 1 for detailed summary
 - **Isolation facilities** have been set up in all high risk districts across the ten provinces; detailed list available at Annex 4 (Note: list is currently under revision following country-wide assessment)
 - Levy Mwanawasa Hospital: 23 patients currently admitted (20 confirmed positive; 3 suspected (results pending). Screening structures have been set up at the facility
 - **Tubalange Hospital:** there are currently no cases admitted at the facility
 - University Teaching Hospital: Screening structures have been set up here as well. There are currently no patients admitted at the facility
 - Masaiti District Hospital: There are currently 2 confirmed positive cases admitted at the facility

3. GAPS AND CHALLENGES

- **Health promotion:** incorrect/inconsistent messages being shared by some media houses
- Logistics: logistical supplies pledged by partners yet to be delivered; currently on GRZ procured items and those donated by the Jack Ma Foundation are in use.
- > Surveillance: incomplete/incorrect contact information provided on surveillance forms

4. PRIORITY ACTIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- ➤ Case management: operational testing of all ventilators; provision of additional PPE; identification of additional space; deployment of additional EHT and auxiliary staff
- ➤ **Health promotion:** provide clearance for standardised messages that can be shared by partners; develop partner directory and identify core teams to provide technical support for different media and platforms
- **Logistics:** continued prepositioning of supplies in all provinces as part of response efforts

5. CONCLUSION

Zambia recorded six additional confirmed cases of COVID-19 bringing the total number to 22. Cases remain confined to Lusaka and Copperbelt provinces. Contact tracing and other surveillance measures to identify all possible cases are being continually strengthened.



ANNEX 3: CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) CASE DEFINITIONS

Case Definitions

1. Suspect case:

A. Patient with acute respiratory infection (fever and at least one sign/symptom of respiratory disease e.g. cough, shortness of breath), AND with no other aetiology that fully explains the clinical presentation AND a history of travel to or residence in a country/area or territory reporting local transmission of COVID-19 during the 14 days prior to symptom onset,

OR

B. Patient with any acute respiratory illness AND having been in contact with a confirmed or probable COVID-19 case in the last 14 days prior to symptom onset,

OR

- C. Patient with severe acute respiratory infection (fever and at least one sign/symptom of respiratory disease e.g. cough, shortness of breath), AND requiring hospitalization AND with no other aetiology that fully explains the clinical presentation
- 2. Probable case: A suspect case for whom testing for COVID-19 is inconclusive or is tested positive using a pan-coronavirus assay and without laboratory evidence of other respiratory pathogens.
- 3. Confirmed case: A person with laboratory confirmation of COVID-19 infection, irrespective of clinical signs and symptoms.
- 4. Person Under Investigation: a suspected case, irrespective of admission status, with either history of travel to an area with local transmission or worked in/attended a health care facility treating COVID-19 infections or admission to a facility for severe pneumonia of unknown aetiology






