HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SITUATION REPORT

- ✓ Fourteen (14) cases tested positive for COVID-19 today. These are all returnees from South Africa and are all isolated.
- ✓ Today 153 RDT screening tests and 354 PCR diagnostic tests were done. The cumulative number of tests done to date is 52 725 (31 371 RDT and 21 354 PCR).
- ✓ To date the total number of confirmed cases is 279; recovered 33, active cases 242 and 4 deaths, since the onset of the outbreak on 20 March 2020.
