HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SITUATION REPORT

- ▼ Fifty-six (56) cases tested positive for COVID-19 today. These include 54 local cases and 2 returnees from South Africa.
- ✓ New recoveries were reported by the following provinces; Bulawayo (47), Mashonaland East (31) and Mat North (3).
- ✓ Today we regret to report (5) deaths which occurred from 03-05 August 2020 in the community and on admission to casualty departments at Parirenyatwa Group of Hospitals and other hospitals after investigations and post mortems were done. These include 2 males and 2 females from Harare province and a baby aged 3 weeks from Matabeleland North province and had respiratory symptoms compatible with COVID-19 and the PCR results were positive for COVID-19.
- Today 1575 RDT screening tests and 961 PCR diagnostic tests were done. The cumulative number of tests done to date is 147 026 (77 923 RDT and 69 103 PCR).
- Since the onset of the COVID-19 outbreak on 20 March 2020, the total number of confirmed cases is 4 451; recovered 1345, active cases 3 004 and 102 deaths.

Provinces with zero PCR done today received positive results from NMRL, NTBRL and Lancet laboratories.

Definition of a death due to COVID-19 for surveillance purposes is a death resulting from a clinically compatible illness, in a probable or confirmed COVID-19 case, unless there is a clear alternative cause of death that cannot be related to COVID disease (e.g. trauma, Diabetes, Asthma, Hypertension, etc.). There should be no period of complete recovery from COVID-19 between illness and death. A death due to COVID-19 may not be attributed to another disease (e.g. cancer) and should be counted independently of pre-existing conditions that are suspected of triggering a severe course of COVID-19.
