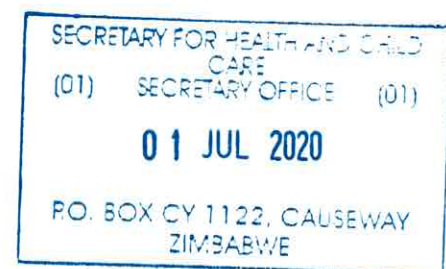
HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SITUATION REPORT

- ✓ Fourteen (14) cases tested positive for COVID-19 today. These include a returnee from South Africa (1), and 13 local cases who are isolated.
- ✓ Two (2) of the local cases are contacts to known confirmed cases, investigations are underway to establish the source of infection for the other eleven (11) cases.
- ✓ Mashonaland East Province reported (3) recoveries.
- ✓ Today 265 RDT screening tests and 380 PCR diagnostic tests were done. The cumulative number of tests done to date is 68 400 (37 309 RDT and 31 091 PCR).
- ✓ To date the total number of confirmed cases is 605; recovered 166, active cases 432 and 7 deaths, since the onset of the outbreak on 20 March 2020.
