HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SITUATION REPORT

- ✓ Six (6) cases tested positive for COVID-19 today. These are all returnees from South Africa and are all isolated.
- ✓ Today 622 RDT screening tests and 552 PCR diagnostic tests were done. The cumulative number of tests done to date is 55 709 (32 904 RDT and 22 805 PCR).
- ✓ Recoveries were reported by Harare Province (2) and Mashonaland West Province (1).
- ✓ To date the total number of confirmed cases is 320; recovered 49, active cases 267 and 4 deaths, since the onset of the outbreak on 20 March 2020.
