HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SITUATION REPORT

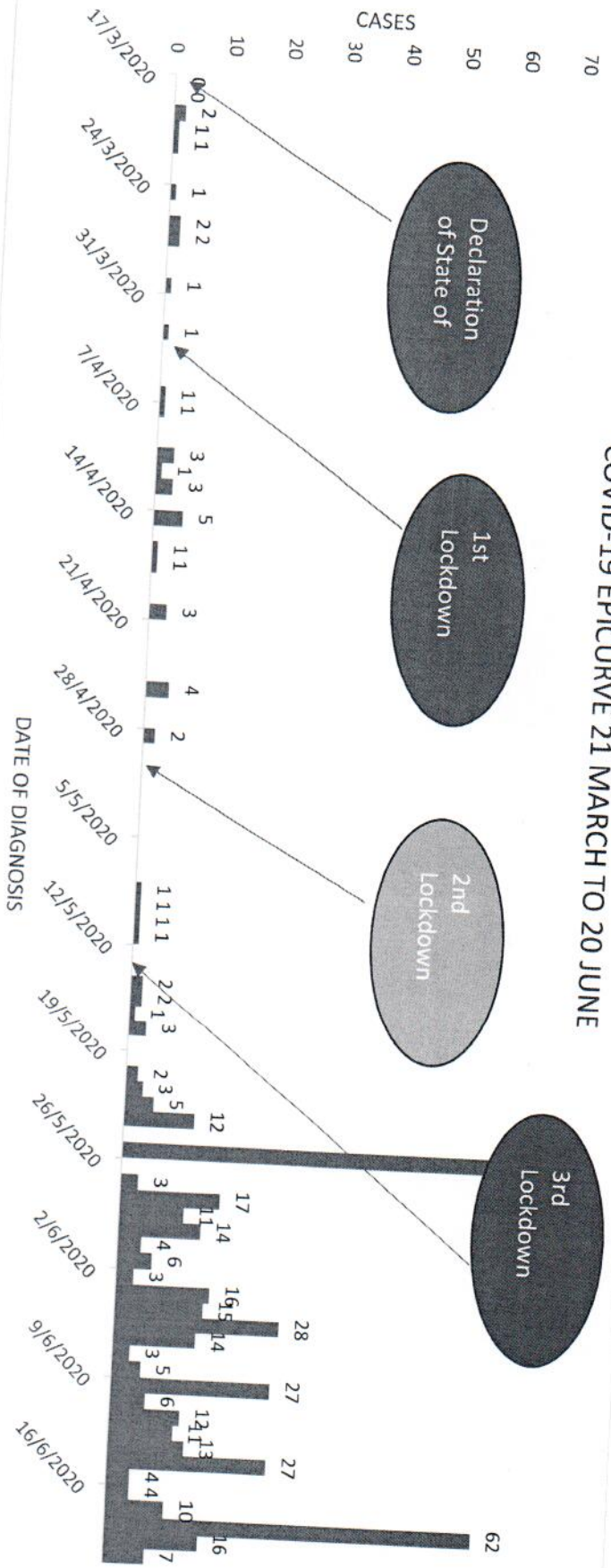
- ✓ Seven (7) cases tested positive for COVID-19 today. These are all returnees from South Africa (6) and Portugal (1) and are isolated.
- ✓ Today we regret to report two (2) deaths, one is a facility death and the other is a community death both females aged 79 and 60 respectively.
- ✓ The facility death is from Bulawayo Province who tested positive on the 17th of June 2020 and had other co-morbidities whilst the community death is from Midlands Province who tested positive for COVID-19 following routine swabbing on the 19th of June 2020.
- ✓ Today 135 RDT screening tests and 334 PCR diagnostic tests were done. The cumulative number of tests done to date is 62 397 (35 946 RDT and 26 451 PCR).
- ✓ To date the total number of confirmed cases is 486; recovered 64, active cases 416 and 6 deaths, since the onset of the outbreak on 20 March 2020.
