## HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SITUATION REPORT

- ✓ Three (3) cases tested positive for COVID-19 today. Two (2) cases are returnees from Botswana who both tested positive on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of quarantine and 1 is a Harare resident with no history of travel.
- $\checkmark$  Today 1 379 RDT screening tests and 466 PCR diagnostic tests were done. The cumulative number of tests done to date is 34 707 (19 623 RDT and 15 084 PCR).
- ✓ To date the total number of confirmed cases is 51; recovered 18, active cases 29 and 4 deaths, since the onset of the outbreak on 20 March 2020.
