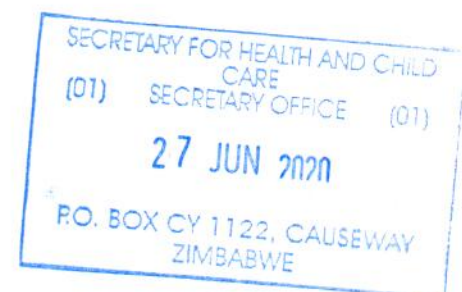

### HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SITUATION REPORT

- ✓ Six (6) cases tested positive for COVID-19 today. These are all returnees from South Africa and are isolated.
- ✓ Seven (7) new recoveries were reported by Matabeleland South Province.
- ✓ Today 70 RDT screening tests and 464 PCR diagnostic tests were done. The cumulative number of tests done to date is 66 238 (36 597 RDT and 29 641 PCR).
- ✓ To date the total number of confirmed cases is 567; recovered 142, active cases 419 and 6 deaths, since the onset of the outbreak on 20 March 2020.
