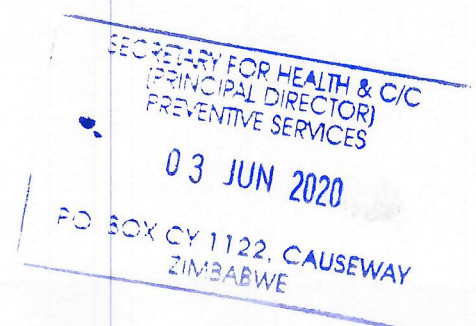
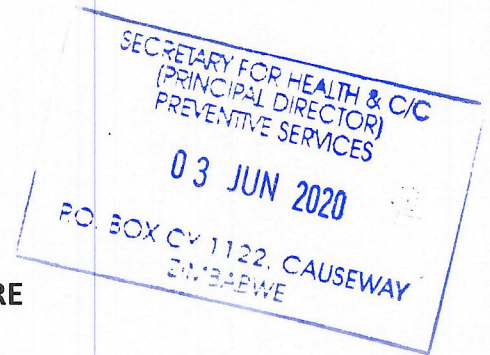

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SITUATION REPORT

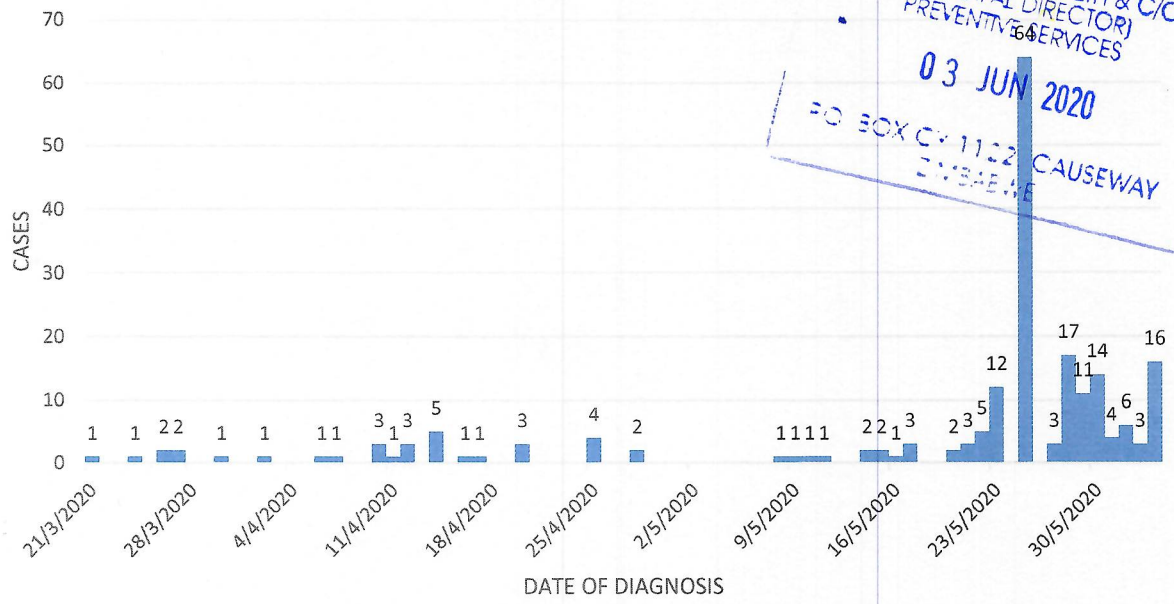
- ✓ Sixteen (16) cases tested positive for COVID-19 today. These are all returnees from South Africa and are all isolated.
- ✓ Today 849 RDT screening tests and 722 PCR diagnostic tests were done. The cumulative number of tests done to date is 49 603(29 951 RDT and 20 012 PCR).
- ✓ To date the total number of confirmed cases is 222; recovered 29, active cases 189 and 4 deaths, since the onset of the outbreak on 20 March 2020.
