HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SITUATION REPORT

- ✓ Fifteen (15) cases tested positive for COVID-19 today. These are all returnees from South Africa and are all isolated.
- ✓ Today 567 RDT screening tests and 390 PCR diagnostic tests were done. The cumulative number of tests done to date is 50 920 (30 518 RDT and 20 402 PCR).
- ✓ To date the total number of confirmed cases is 237; recovered 31, active cases 202 and 4 deaths, since the onset of the outbreak on 20 March 2020.

* In yesterday's report 5 cases were deducted from Harare Province and added to Mat. South Province, thus giving a cumulative figure of 93 cases for Harare and 21 cases for Mat South. This was due to a data verification exercise that was done using linelists from both provinces which showed that 5 cases from Mat South were being reported under Harare Province in the daily update.
