### COVID-19 UPDATE

Date of issue: 05/06/2020

#### HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SITUATION REPORT

- ✓ Twenty-eight (28) cases tested positive for COVID-19 today. These are all returnees from South Africa and are all isolated.
- ✓ Today 700 RDT screening tests and 598 PCR diagnostic tests were done. The cumulative number of tests done to date is 52 218 (31 218 RDT and 21 000 PCR).
- ✓ To date the total number of confirmed cases is 265; recovered 33, active cases 228 and 4 deaths, since the onset of the outbreak on 20 March 2020.
