



## Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 01/12/2020

## **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- 95 New Cases and No Death reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases remains at 104).
- 1029 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 9.2%)
- All 95 are local cases
- 154 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 85.3% and Active cases go up to 1209 today
- As of 01 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded 10 129 Cases 8643 recoveries and 277 Deaths.

#### **CASES AND DEATHS DISTRIBUTION**





## Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate




- Cumulative cases curve spiking

### Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




#### **COMMENTS**

#### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




#### **COMMENTS**

## **COMMENTS**


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises







