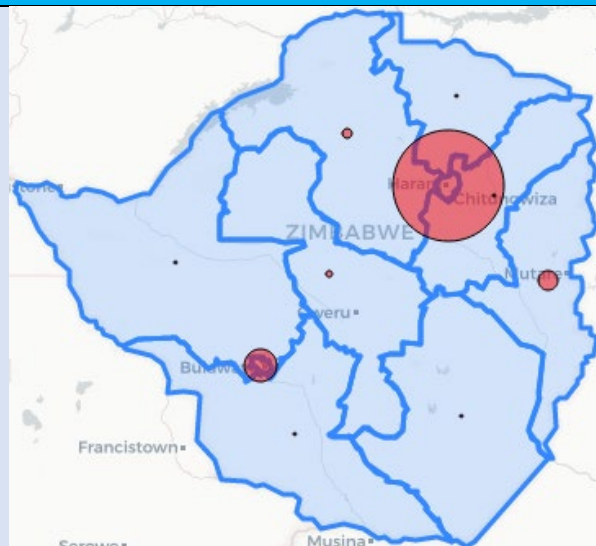
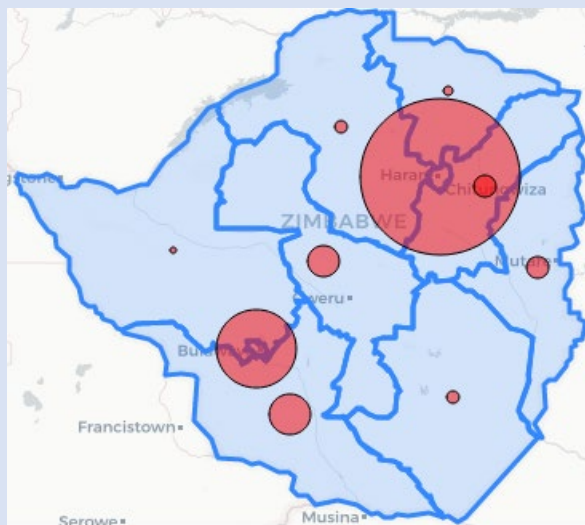


Zimbabwe MOHCC Covid-19 SitRep 01/09/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

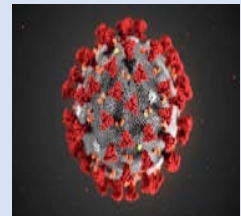
- **62** New Cases and **1** Death reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases further declines to 51 from 61 yesterday. The death was reported from Bulawayo.)
- **1013** PCR tests done today (positivity for today was **6.1%**)
- **51** are local cases and **11** are returnees from SA.
- **20** total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at **79.9%** and Active cases go up to **1115** today
- As of 1 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded **6559** Cases **5241** recoveries and **203** Deaths.

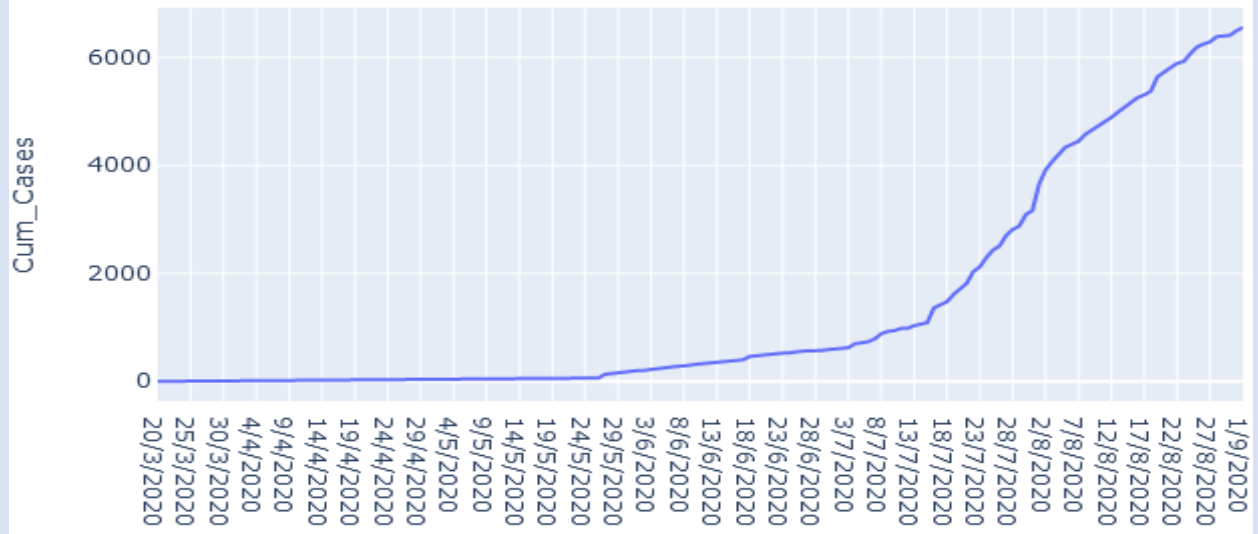

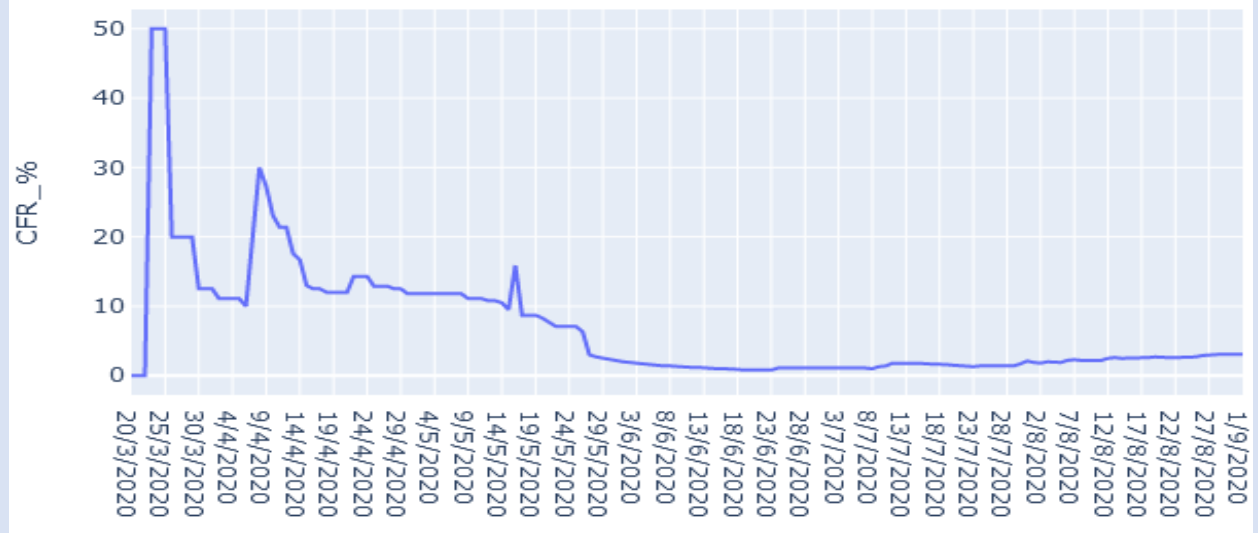

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cumulative Cases

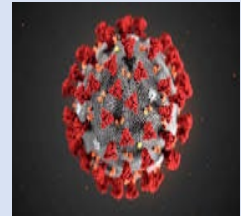


Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



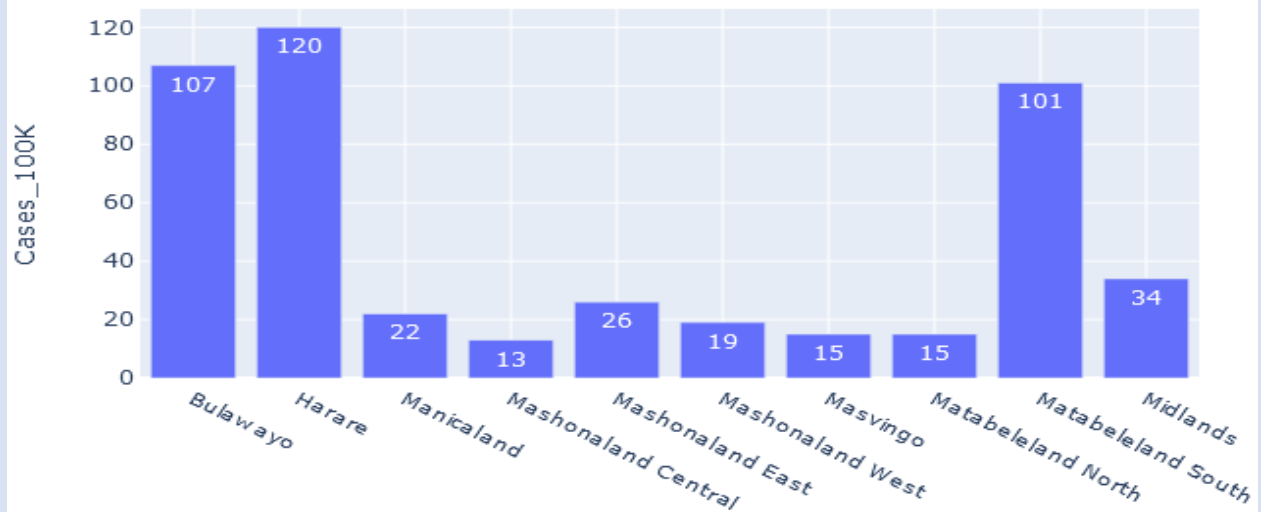
COMMENTS

- National Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at **3.1 %** as at 01/9/20

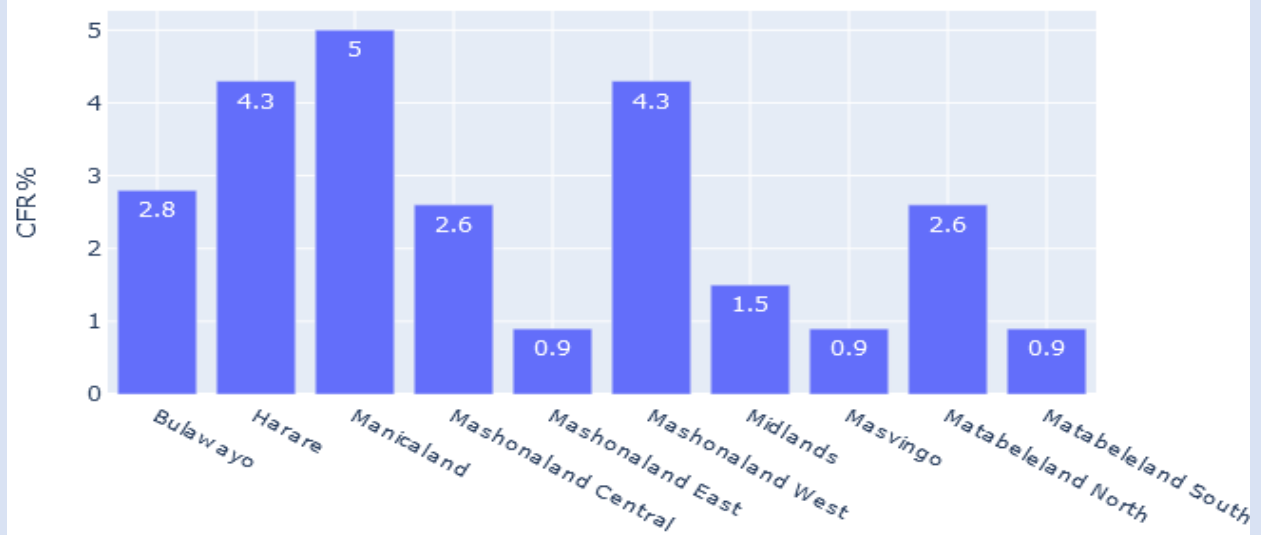

Zimbabwe Covid Cases Per 100K Popn

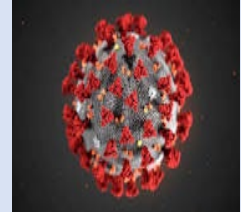


Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province



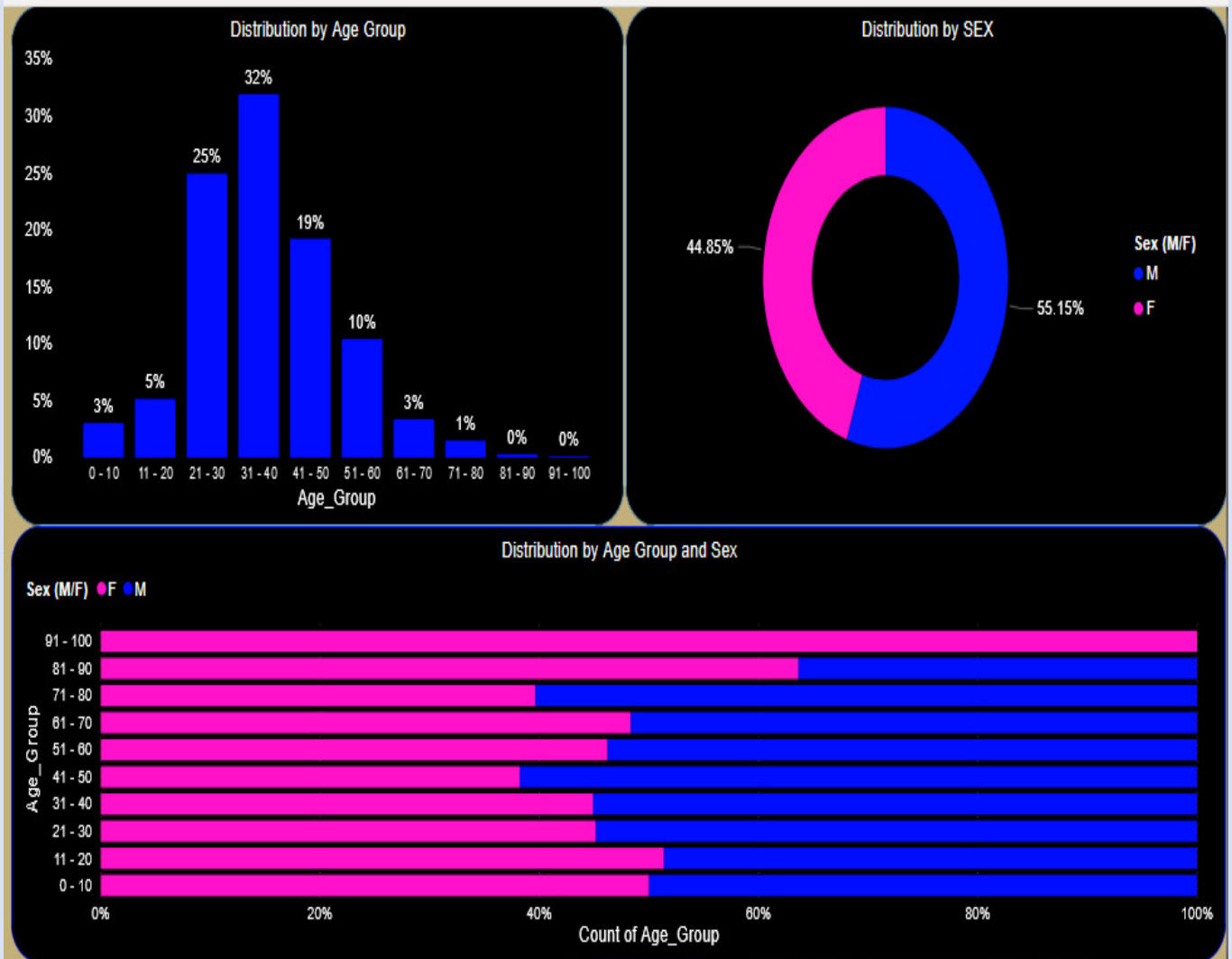
COMMENTS

- Manicaland has the highest case fatality ratio followed by Mash West and Harare



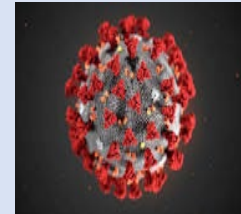
CHARACTERISTICS OF CASES

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



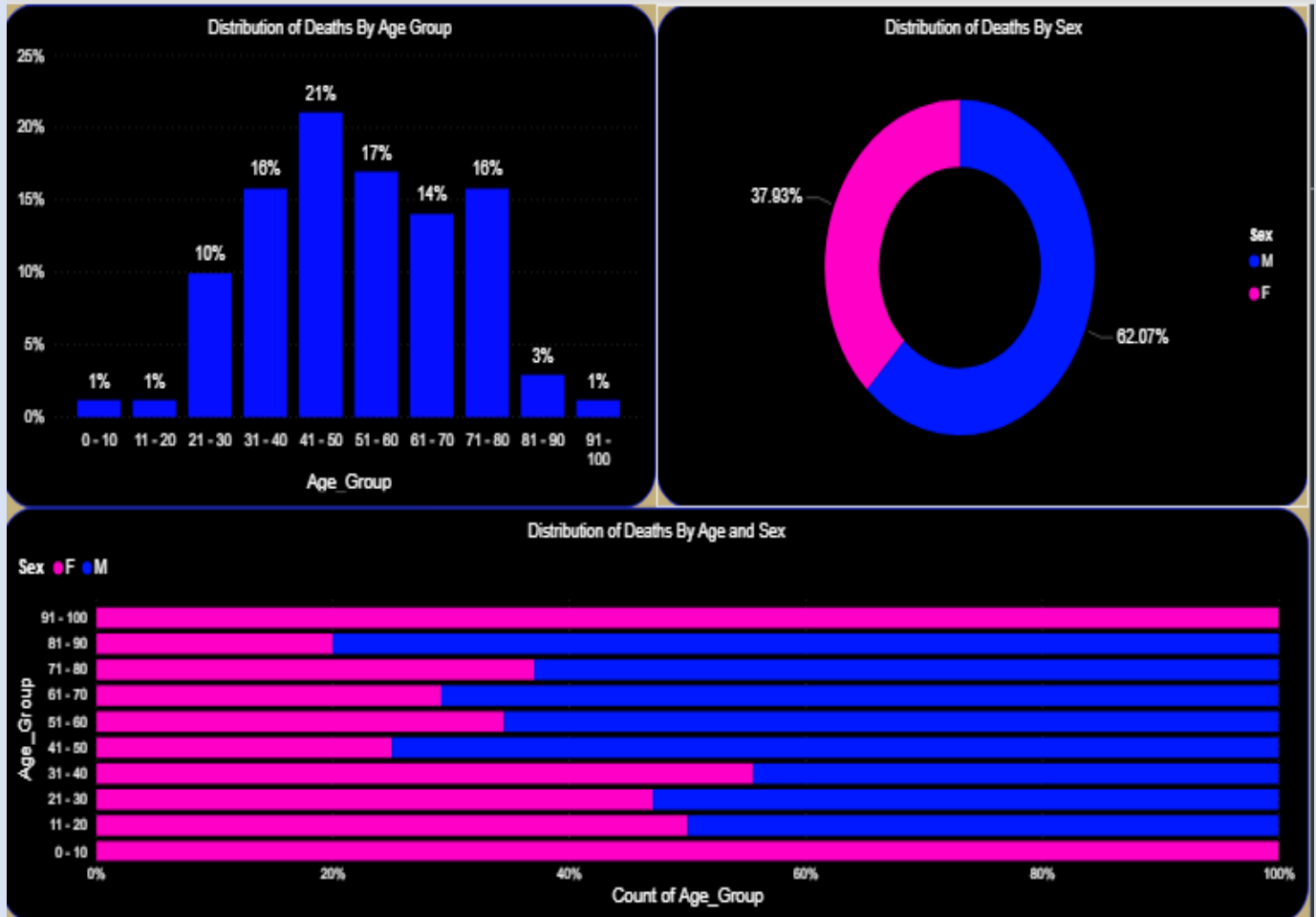
COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths

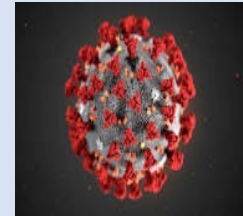


COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises

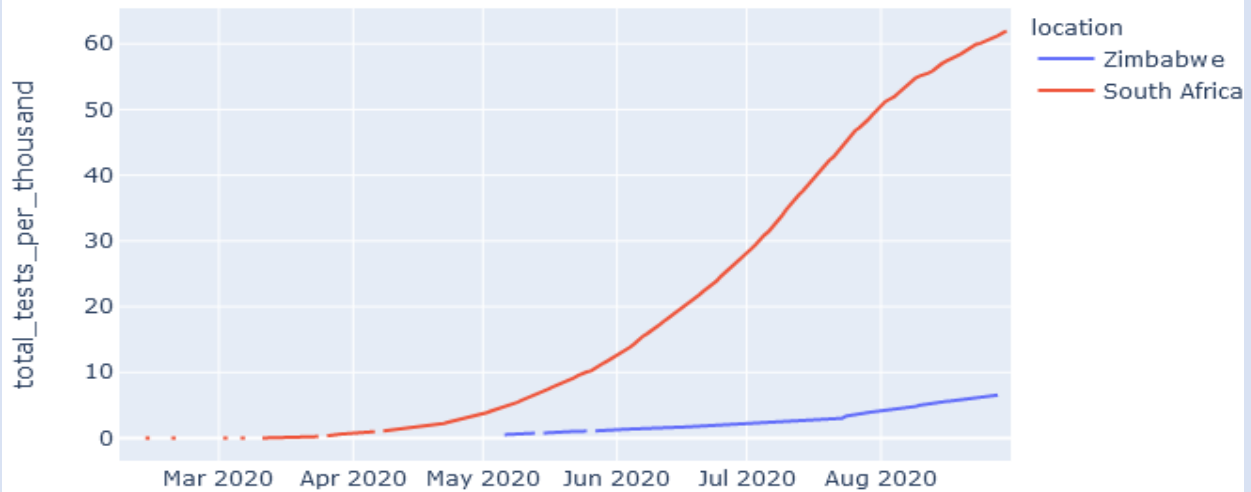

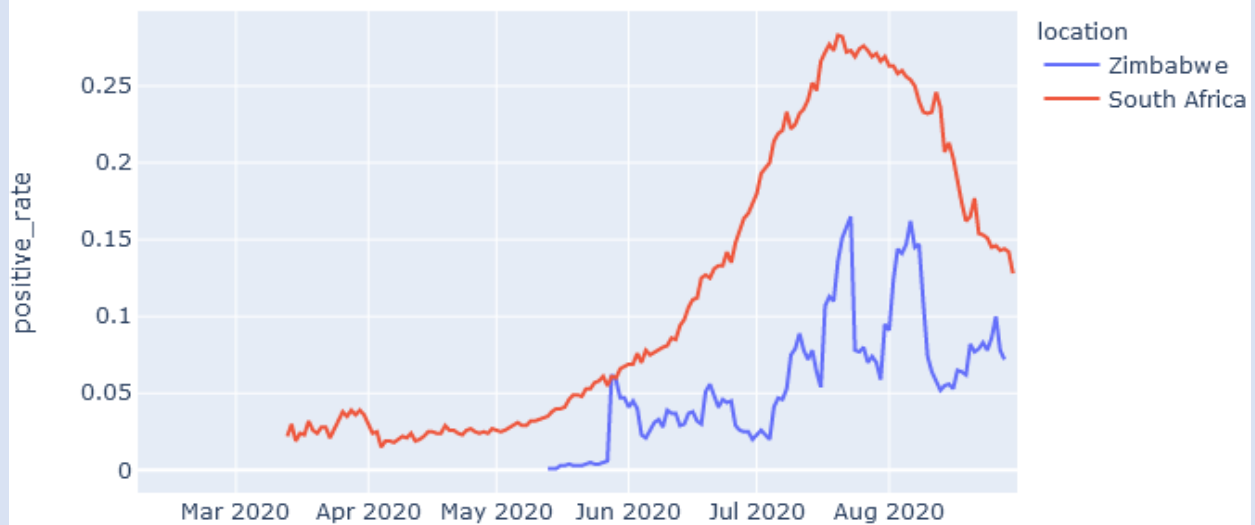

Covid-19 Testing Trends



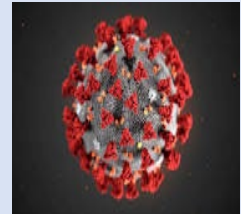
Covid-19 Positivity Zimbabwe and SA

- **Overall Positivity has decreased to 7.2%**

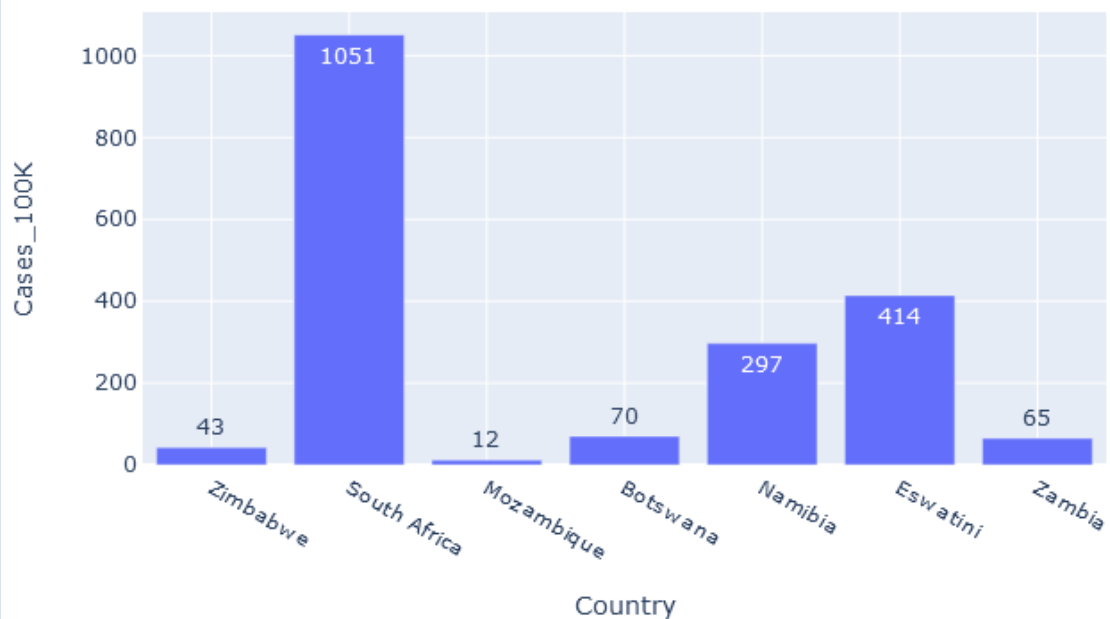

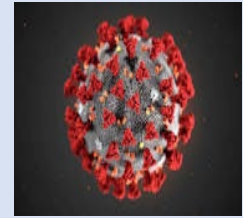

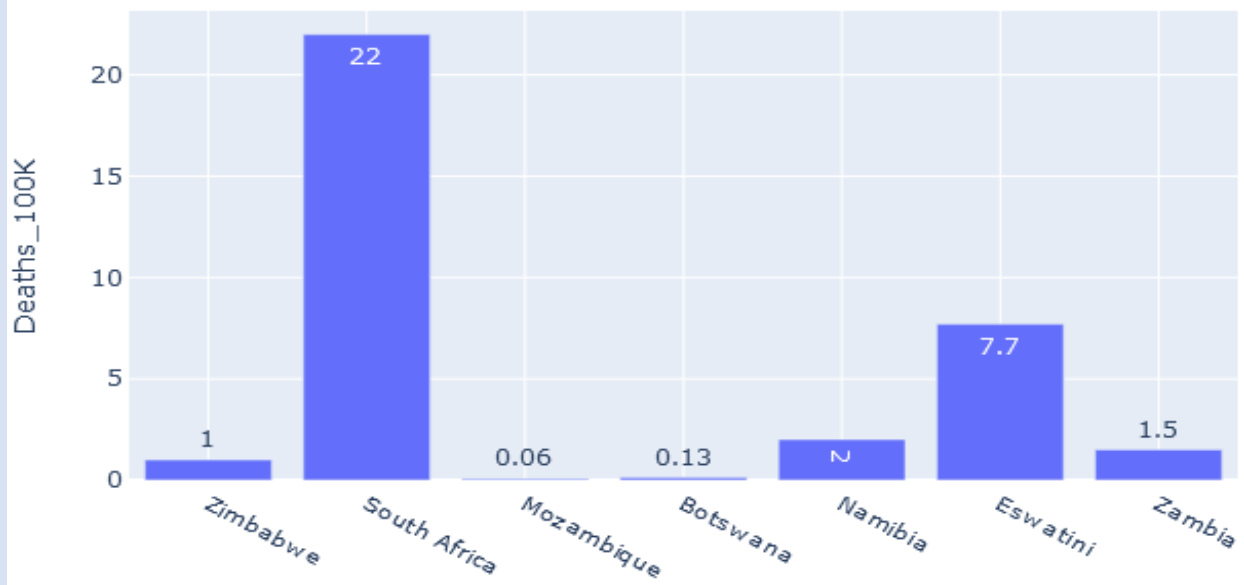
