



## Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 02/12/2020

## **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- **114** New Cases and No Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases rises to 105 from 104 yesterday).
- 1862 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 6.1%)
- All **114** are local cases
- 28 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 84.7% and Active cases go up to 1295 today
- As of 02 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded **10243** Cases **8671** recoveries and **277** Deaths.




#### COMMENTS

#### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases






- More males affected when compared to females


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)






Zimbabawe Covid-19 Cases In Last Seven Days
