



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 02/10/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 8 New Cases and No Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases goes down to 10 from 14 yesterday).
- 692 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 1.2%)
- 6 are local cases and 2 are returnees from SA
- 10 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 80% and Active cases go down to 1308 today
- As of 2 October 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 7858 Cases 6322 recoveries and 228 Deaths.









- Cumulative cases curve flattening


COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




COMMENTS


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises






