



## Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 02/09/2020

## **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- **79** New Cases and **3** Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases goes up to 55 from 51 yesterday. The deaths were reported from Bulawayo, Mat South and Manicaland- all 1 each.)
- \*Mash West has reported 101 cases in the last seven days
- 939 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 8.4%)
- 59 are local cases and 20 are returnees from SA.
- 9 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 79% and Active cases go up to 1182 today
- As of 2 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 6638 Cases 5250 recoveries and 206 Deaths.










## Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate




### COMMENTS

- National Case fatality Rate now stands at 3.1 % as at 02/9/20



## Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




### COMMENTS

#### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




#### COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises






- The trends show that when compared to South Africa Zimbabwe has been testing much less per capita but testing rates in Zimbabwe are increasing



- \*The Seven-Day Rolling average or moving average is used to take care of fluctuations in sample processing due by weekends or backlogs due to other operational issues. It is a mean of the last seven days' cases and it is calculated daily. It is used to highlight a finer trend of the variable being reported in this case New Covid-19 Cases in Zimbabwe.
- Mashonaland West has reported an increased number of cases in the last seven days
