



### Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 03/12/2020

### **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**


- 181 New Cases and 3 Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases rises to 114 from 105 yesterday).
- 1294 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 14%)
- **178** are local cases and **3** are returnees from Algeria (*Deaths reported by Bulawayo*(2) and *Manicaland*(1))
- 83 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 84.7% and Active cases go up to 1390 today
- As of 03 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded 10424 Cases 8754 recoveries and 280 Deaths.




### COMMENTS

# Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




#### COMMENTS

#### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases






- More males affected when compared to females


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)






