

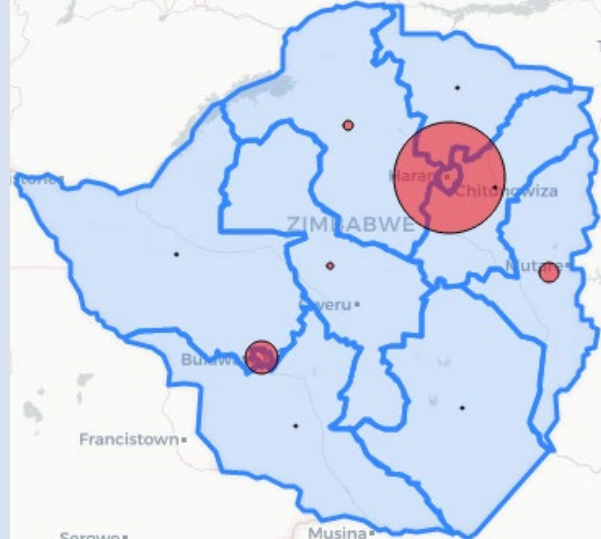
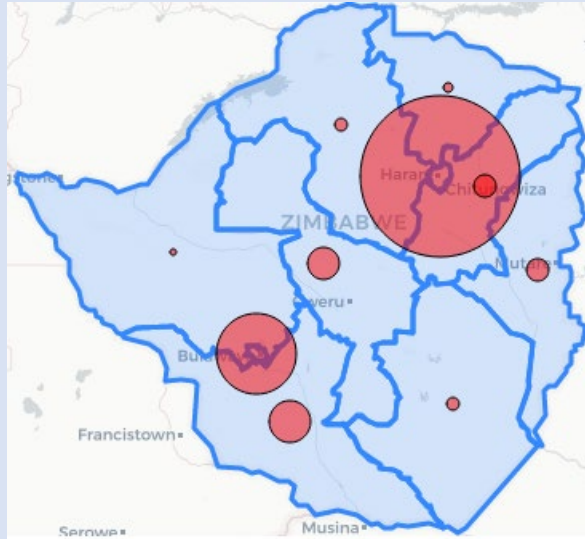


Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 03/12/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- **181** New Cases and **3** Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases rises to **114** from **105** yesterday).
- **1294** PCR tests done today (Positivity today was **14%**)
- **178** are local cases and **3** are returnees from Algeria (Deaths reported by Bulawayo(2) and Manicaland(1))
- **83** new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at **84.7%** and Active cases go up to **1390** today
- As of 03 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded **10424** Cases **8754** recoveries and **280** Deaths.

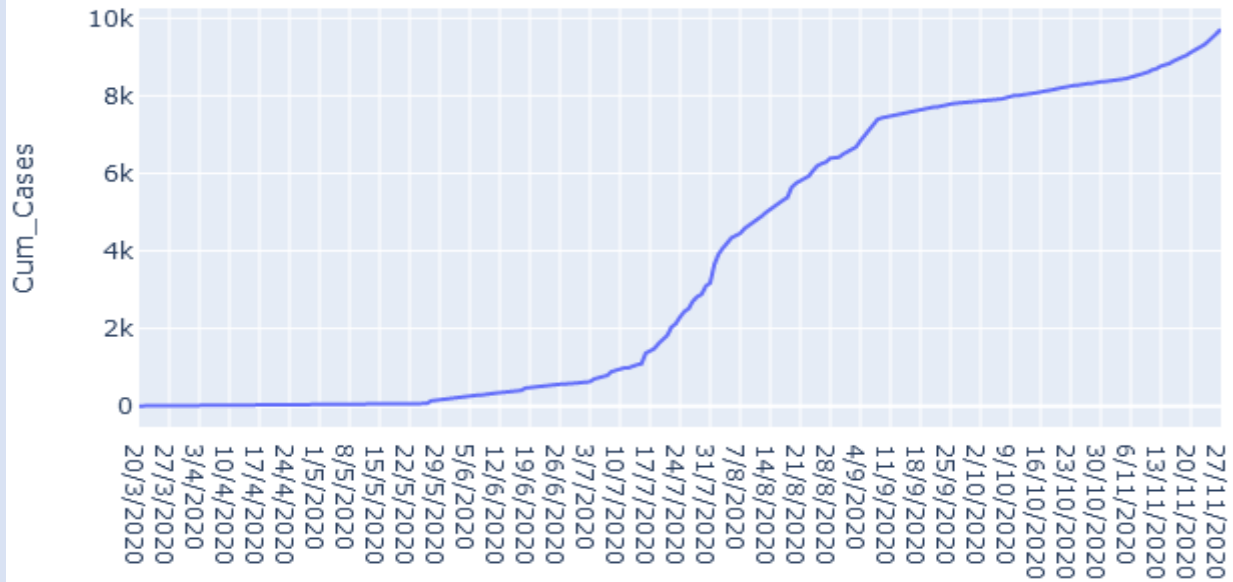

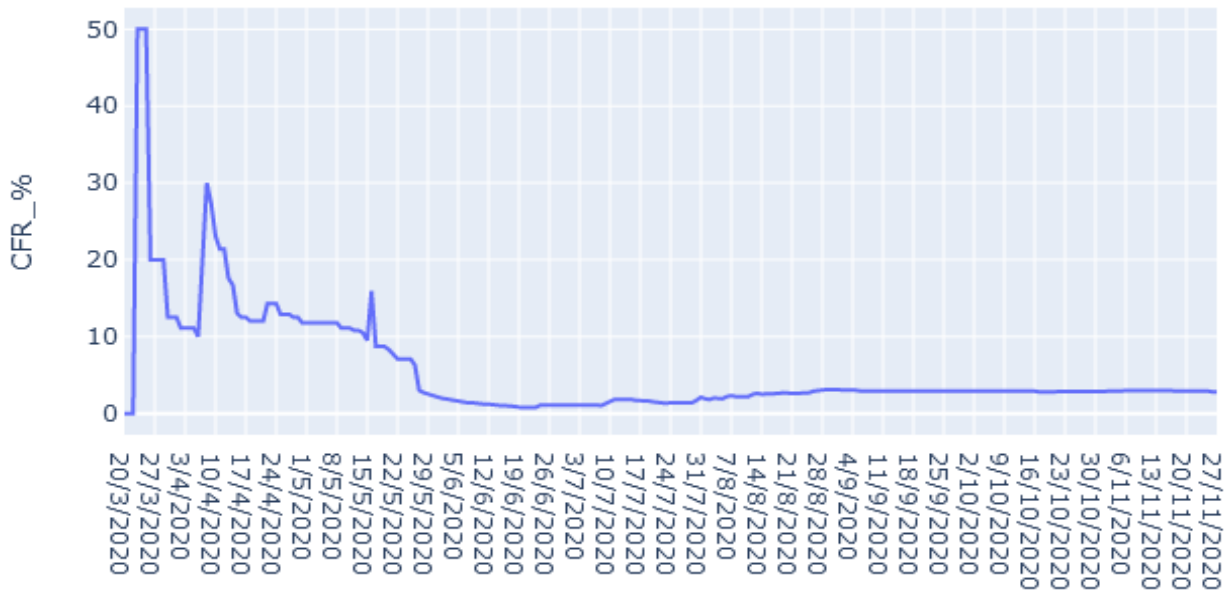

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



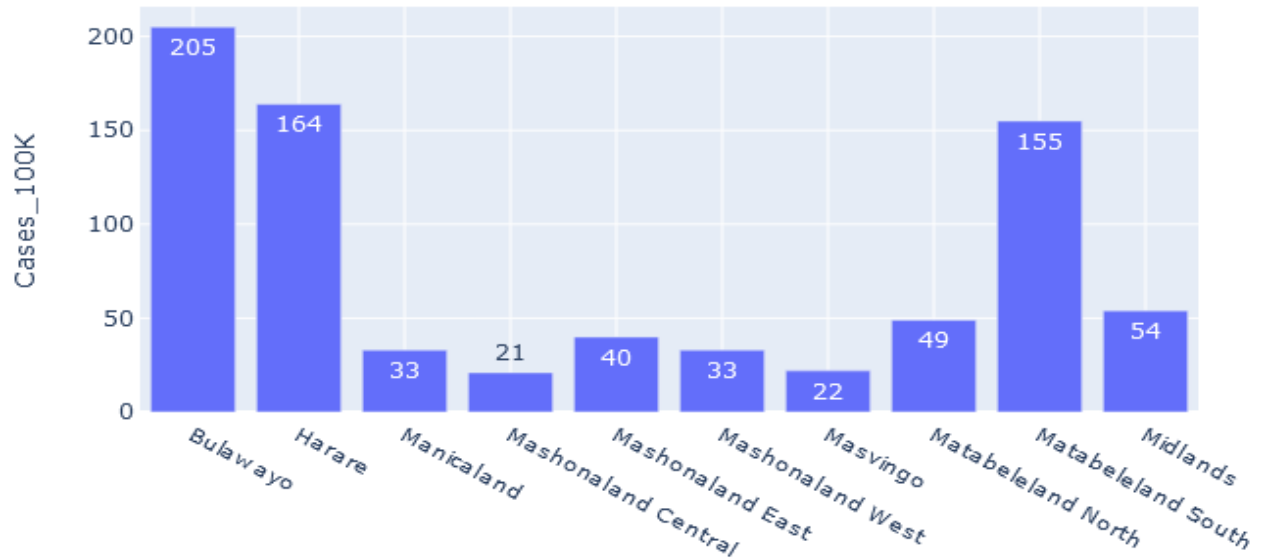
COMMENTS

- National Case fatality Rate now stands at **2.7 %** as at 03/12/20

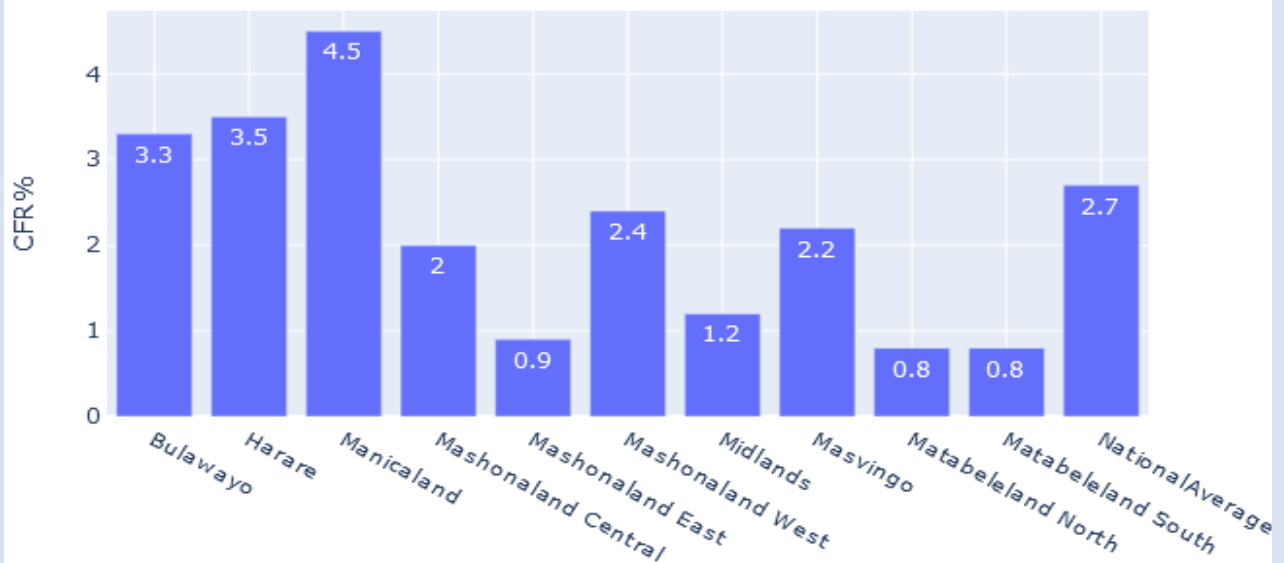

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



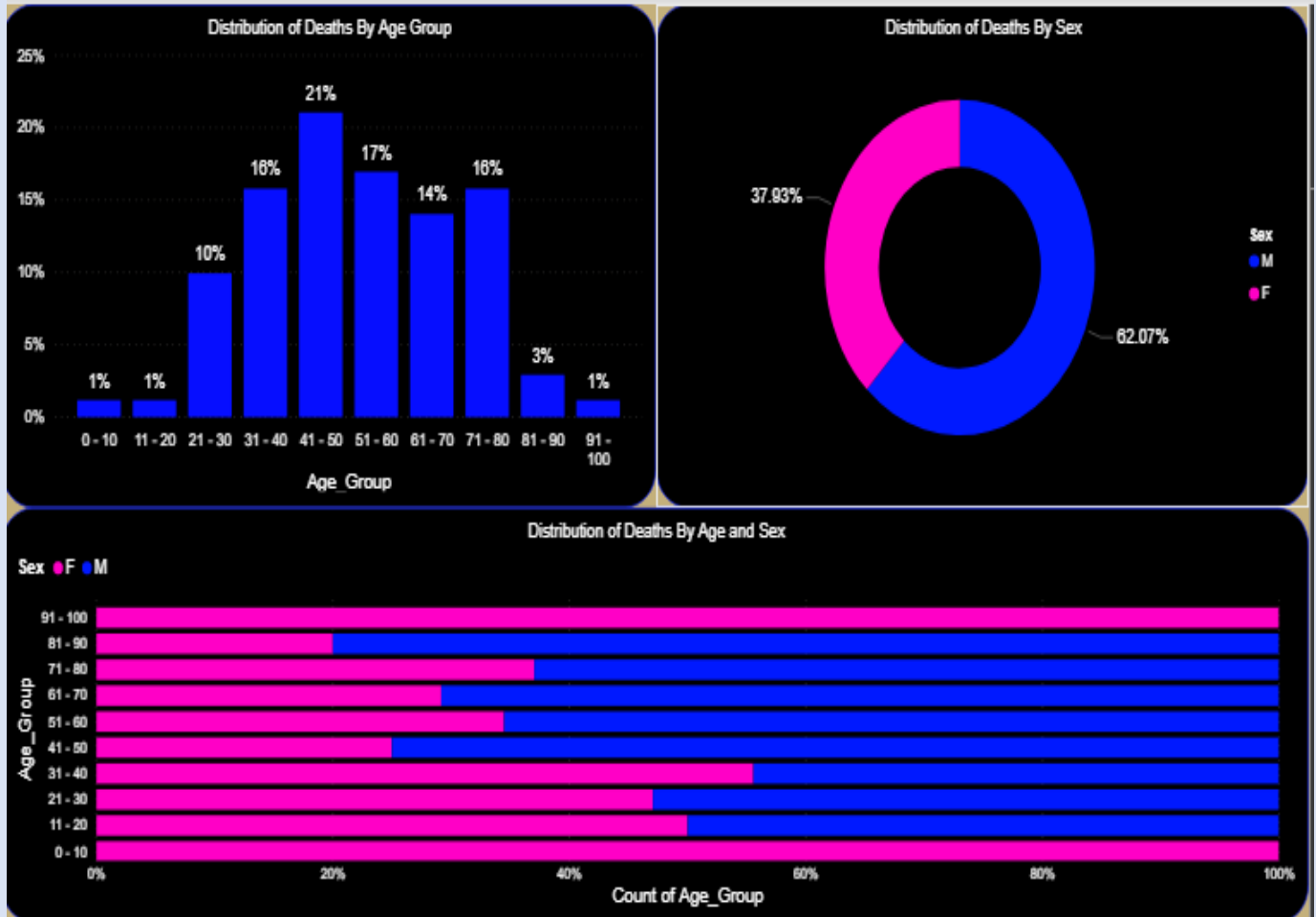
COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises

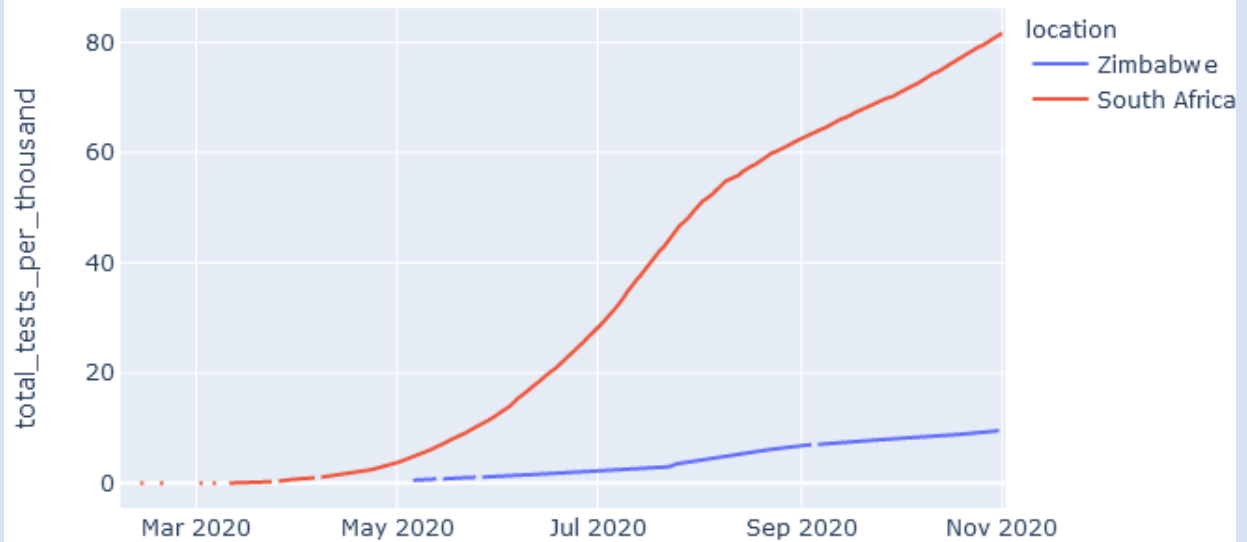

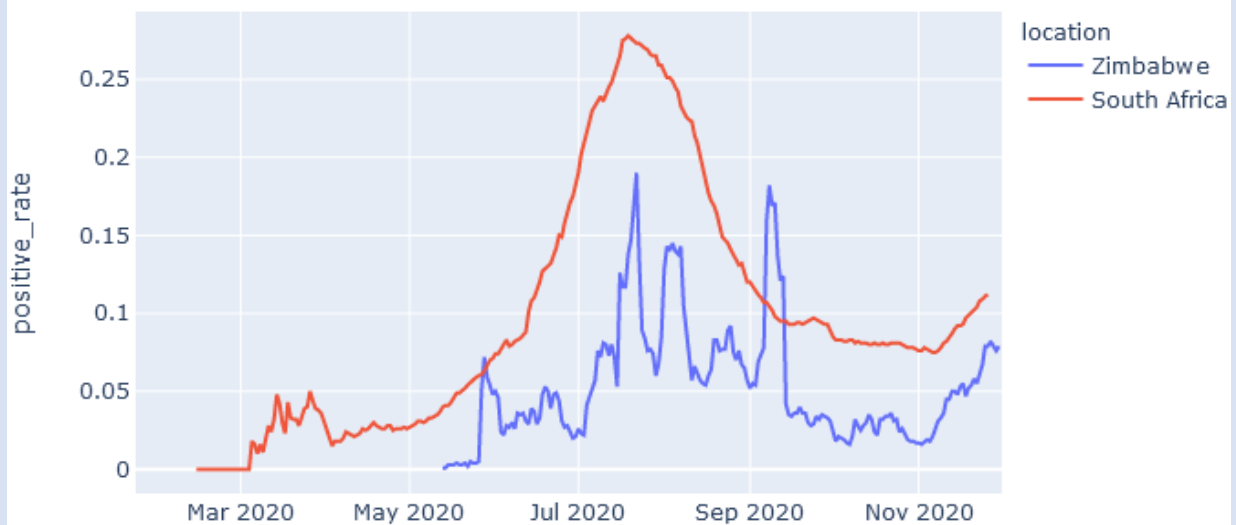

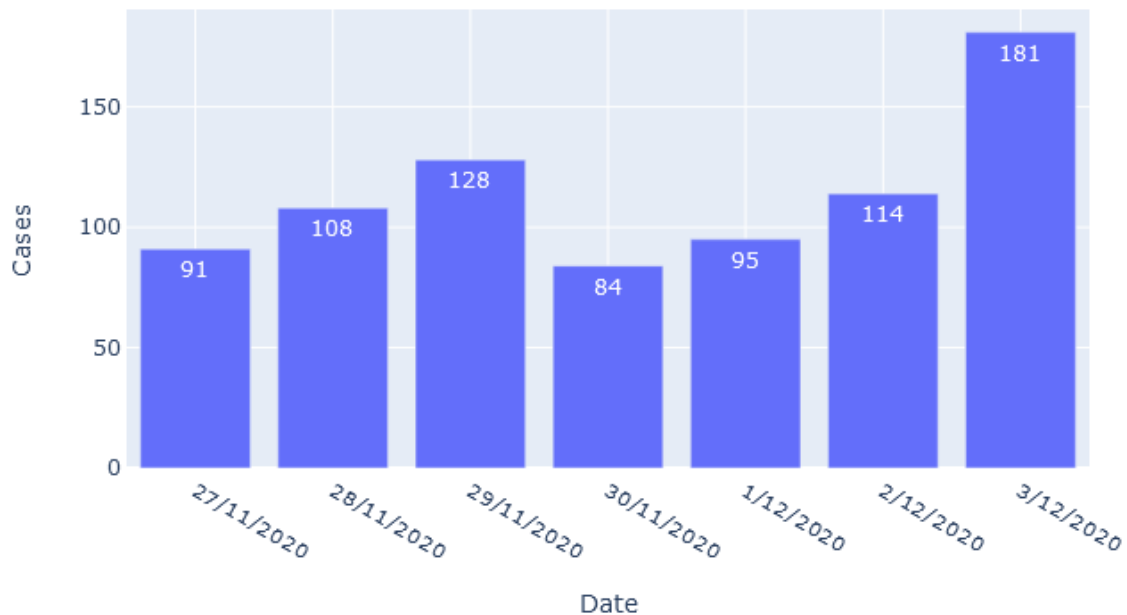

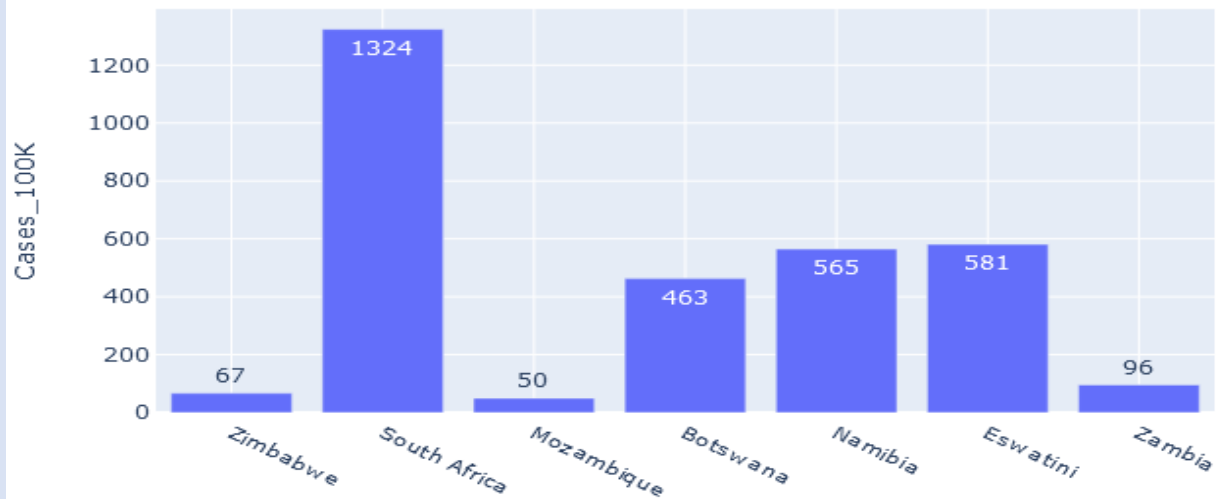

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cases In Last Seven Days

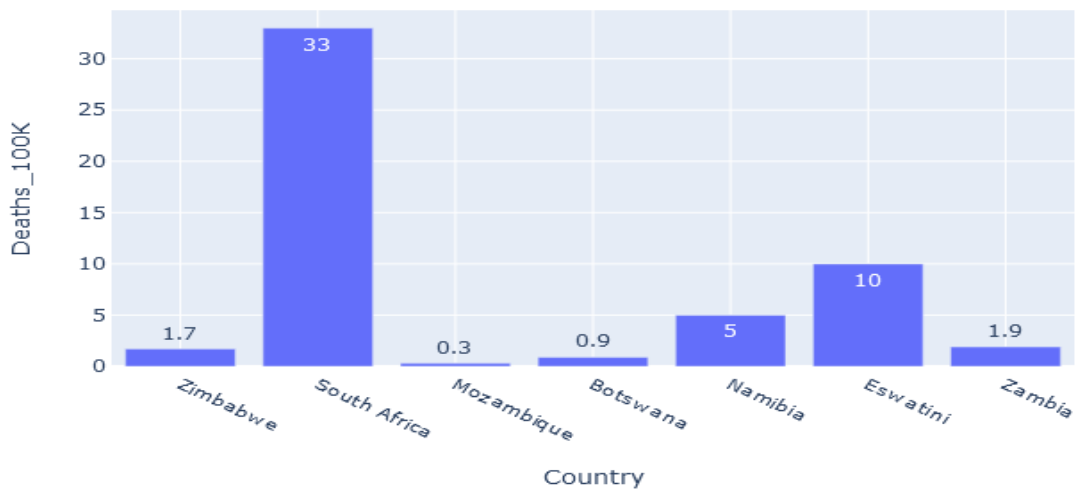




SADC Covid Cases Per 100K Population
