



# Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 03/10/2020

### **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- 27 New Cases and No Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases goes up to 12 from 10 yesterday).
- 421 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 6.4%)
- 22 are local cases and 5 are returnees from SA
- 5 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 80% and Active cases go up to 1330 today
- As of 3 October 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 7885 Cases 6327 recoveries and 228 Deaths.








- Cumulative cases curve flattening

### Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




#### **COMMENTS**

### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




### **COMMENTS**


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises






