



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 03/09/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY


- 40 New Cases and No Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases stays at 55 today).
- 1095 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 3.7%)
- 5 are local cases 35 are returnees from SA(34) and Botswana(1).
- 13 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate still stands at 79% and Active cases go up to 1209 today
- As of 3 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 6678 Cases 5263 recoveries and 206 Deaths.





Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate





Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases






- More males affected when compared to females


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)

• Overall Positivity has decreased to 7.2%




