



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 04/11/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY


- **17** New Cases and **2** Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases rises to 15 from 13 yesterday).
- 854 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 2.0%)
- All 17 are local cases
- 25 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 94.5% and Active cases go down to 212 today
- As of 4 November 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 8427 Cases 7967 recoveries and 248 Deaths.

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



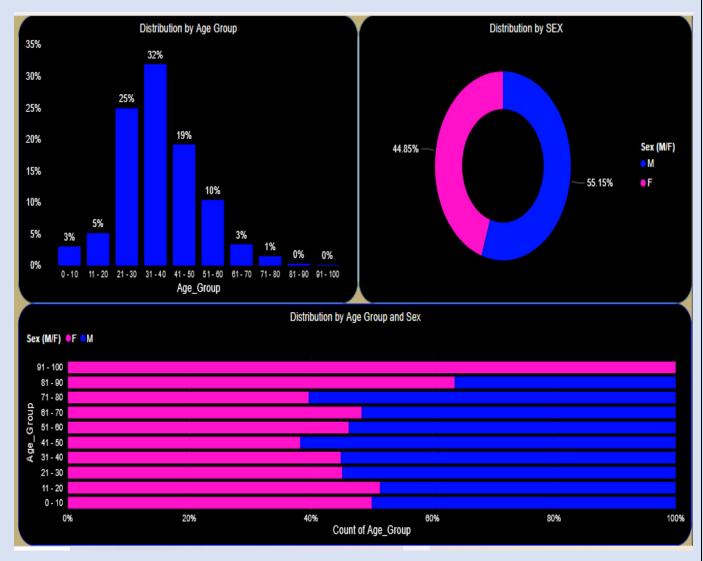
COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



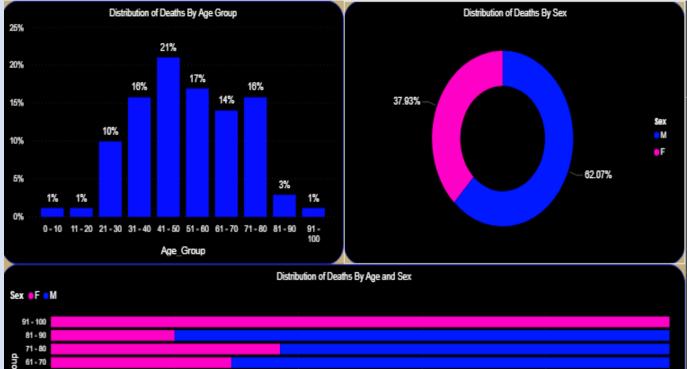

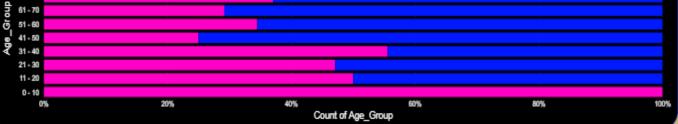
- More males affected when compared to females


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)




