



# Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 04/10/2020

#### **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- **3** New Cases and No Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases goes down to 11 from 12 yesterday).
- 217 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 1.4%)
- All 3 are local cases
- 32 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate rises to 81% and Active cases go down to 1301 today
- As of 4 October 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 7888 Cases 6359 recoveries and 228 Deaths.








#### Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate




- Cumulative cases curve flattening


#### COMMENTS

#### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases






- More males affected when compared to females






