

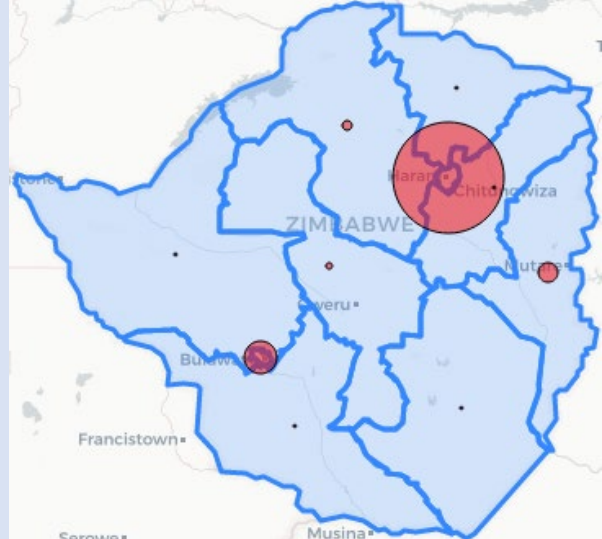
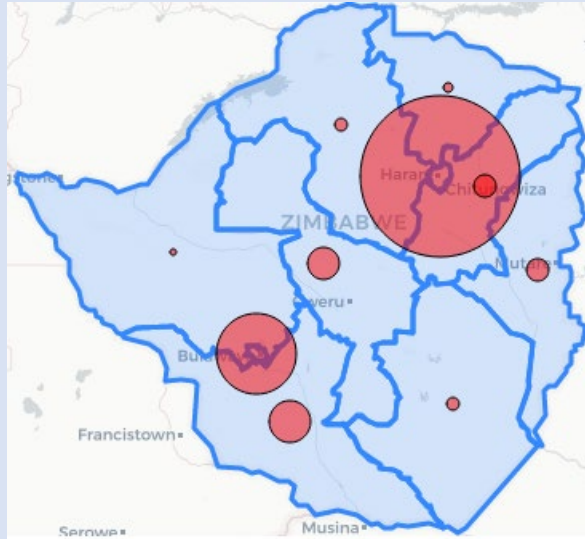


Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 04/09/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- **159** New Cases and **No** Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases goes up to **64** today from **55** yesterday).
- **919** PCR tests done today (positivity for today was **17.3%**)
- **158** are local cases while **1** is a returnee Botswana. Harare reported 144 cases: these are from a backlog of samples collected over the last week which are now being processed.
- **82** total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at **78%** and Active cases go up to **1286** today
- As of 4 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded **6837** Cases **5345** recoveries and **206** Deaths.

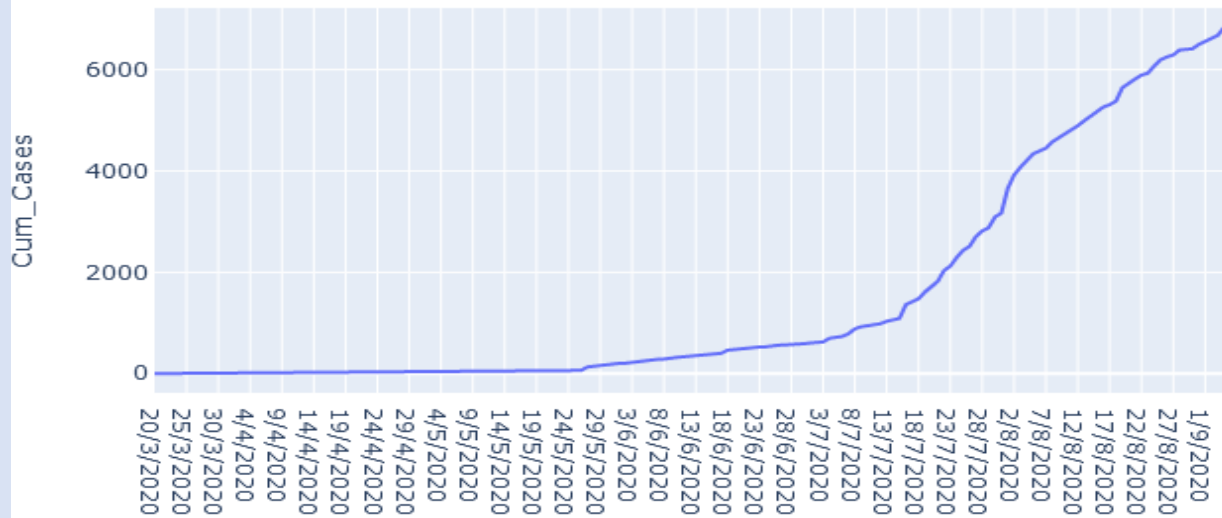

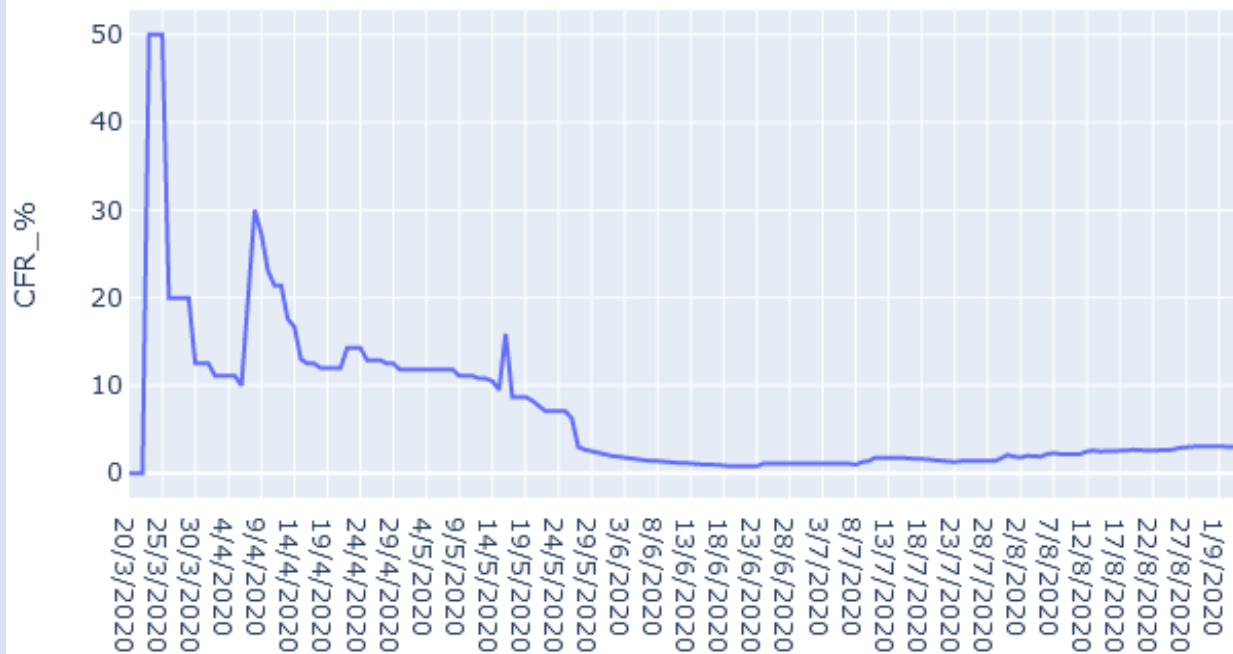

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



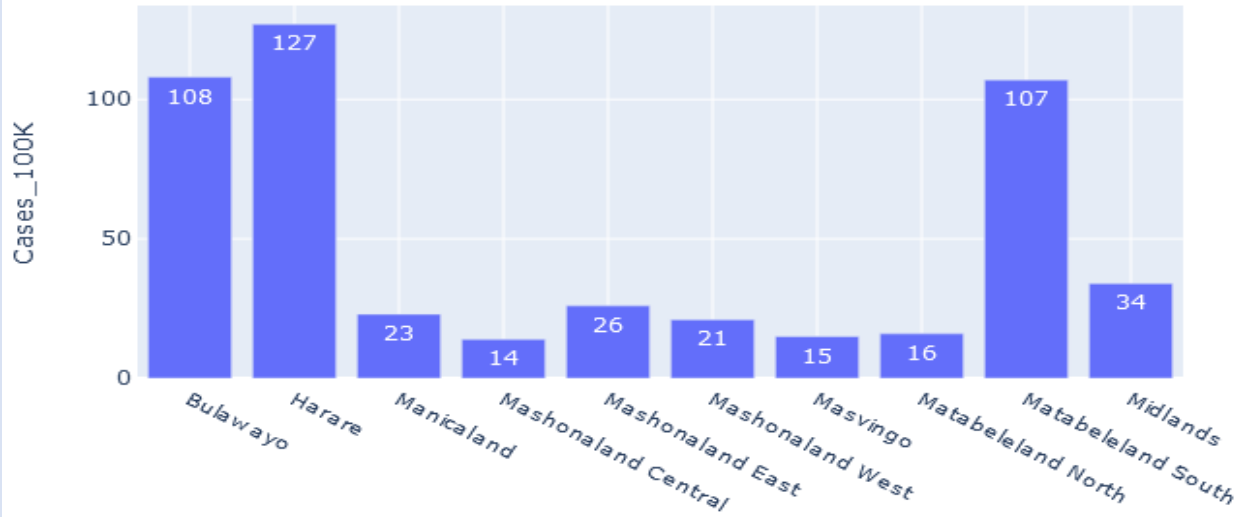
COMMENTS

- National Case fatality Rate now stands at **3.0 %** as at 04/9/20

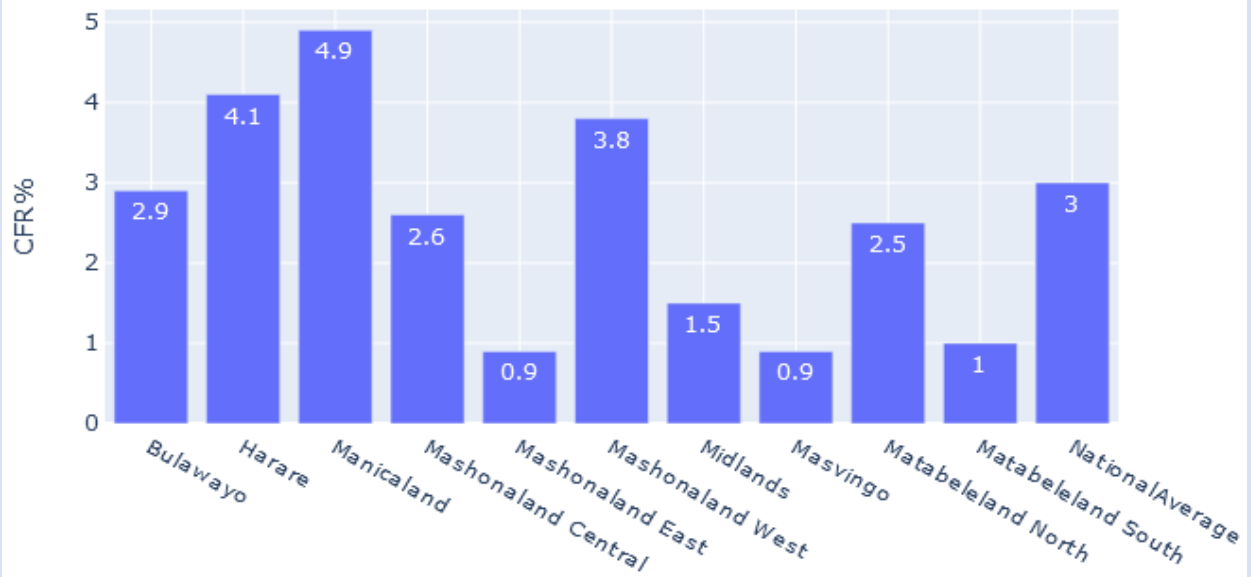

Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province



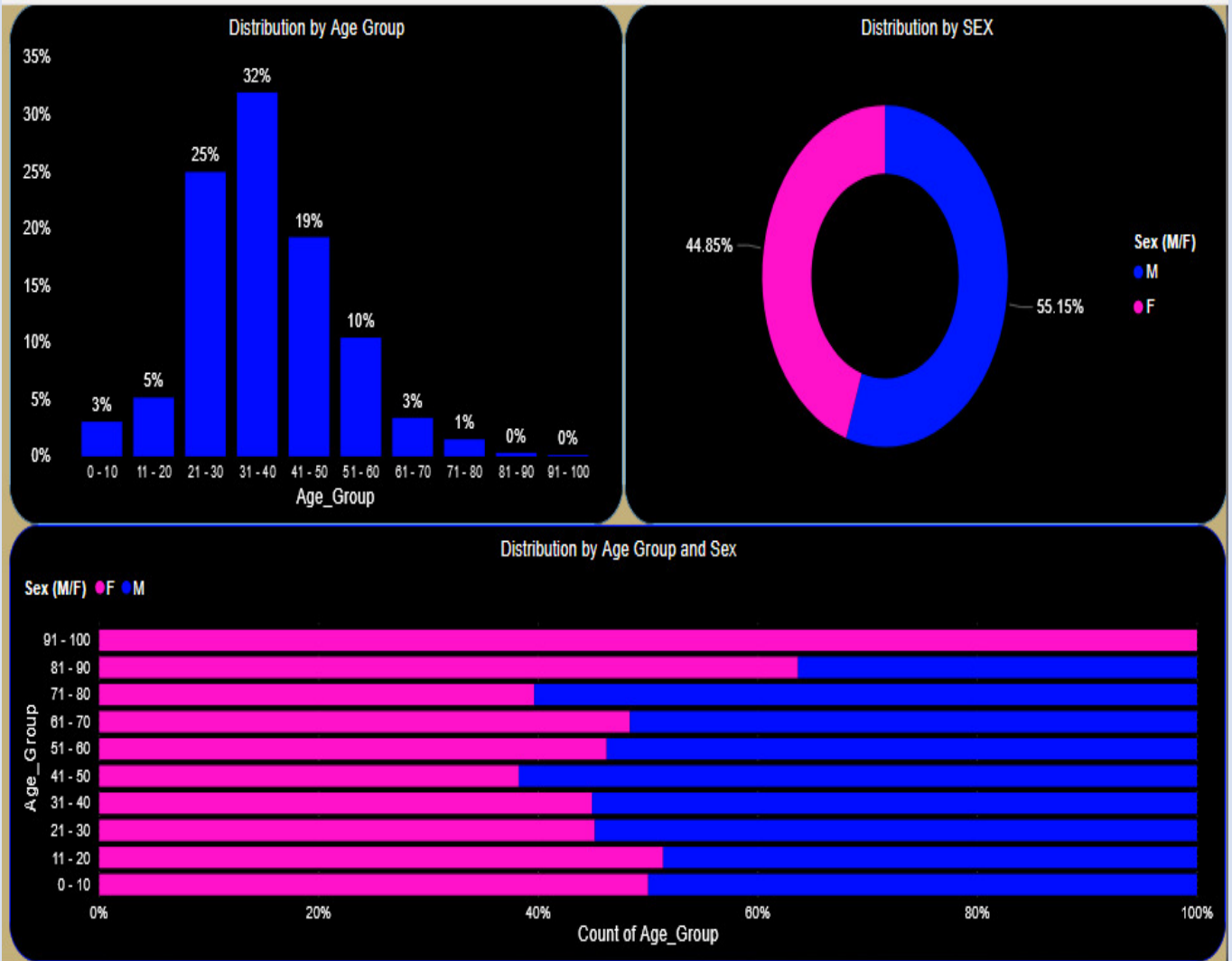
COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



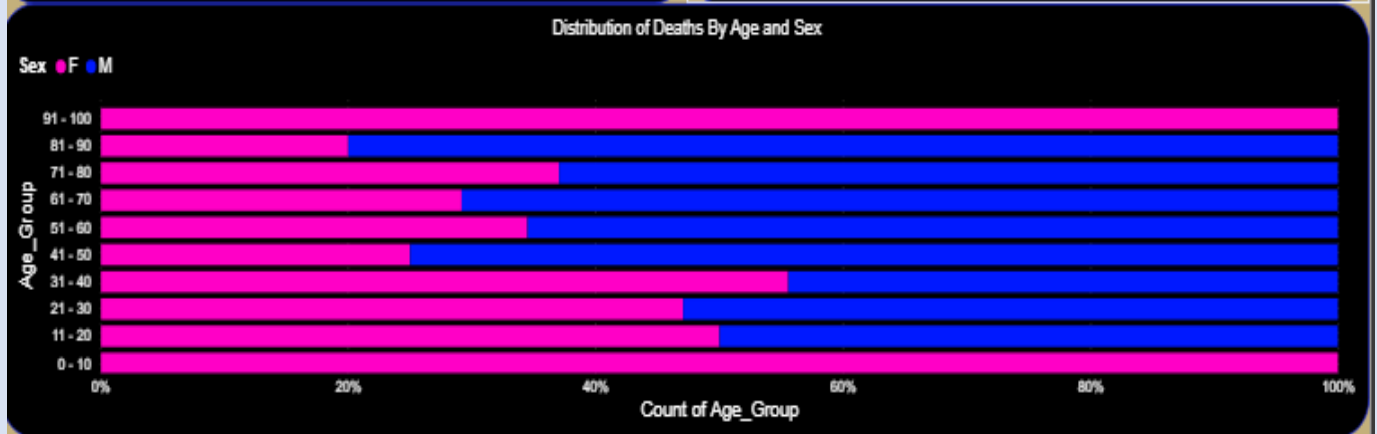
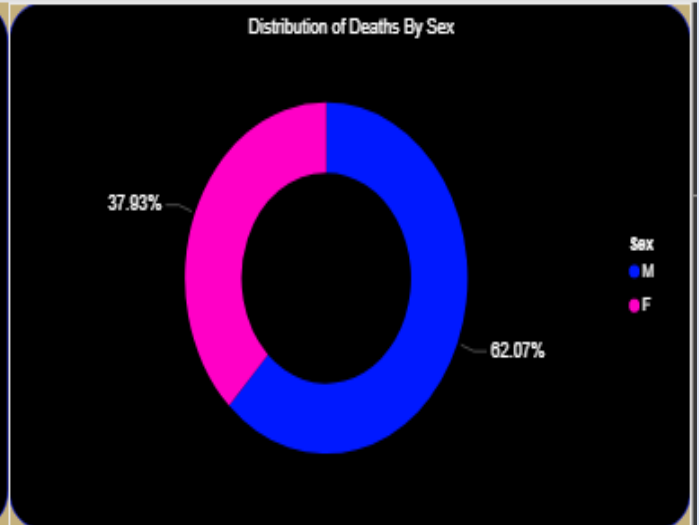
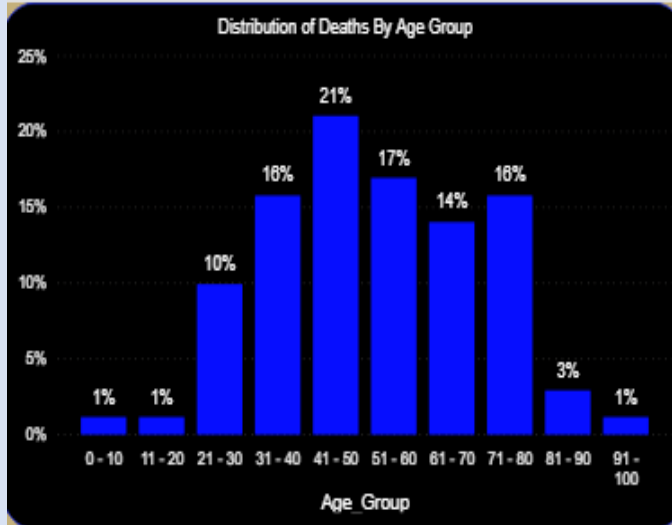
COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises

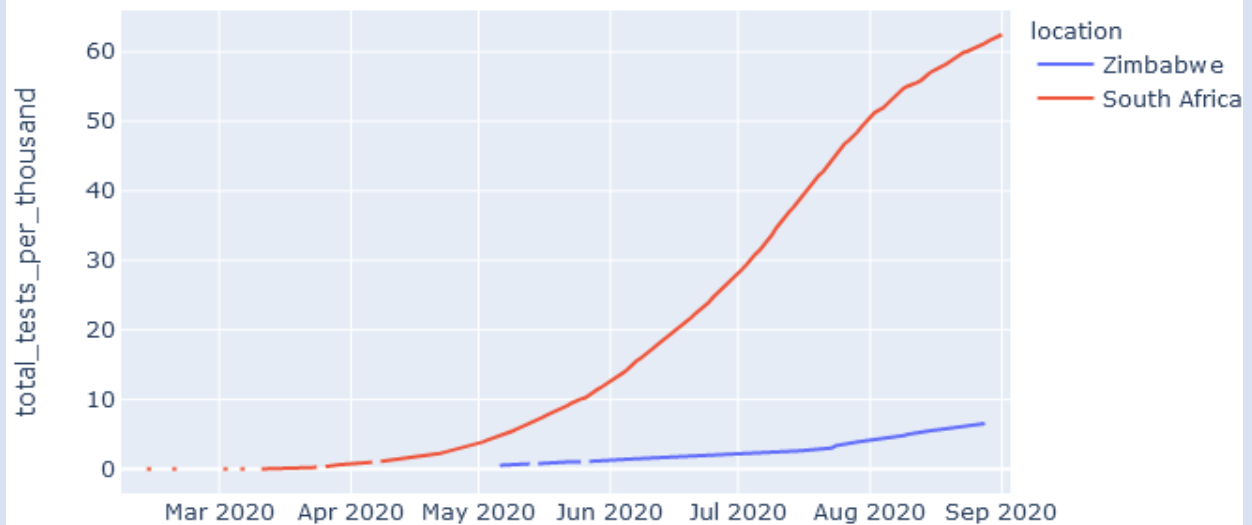

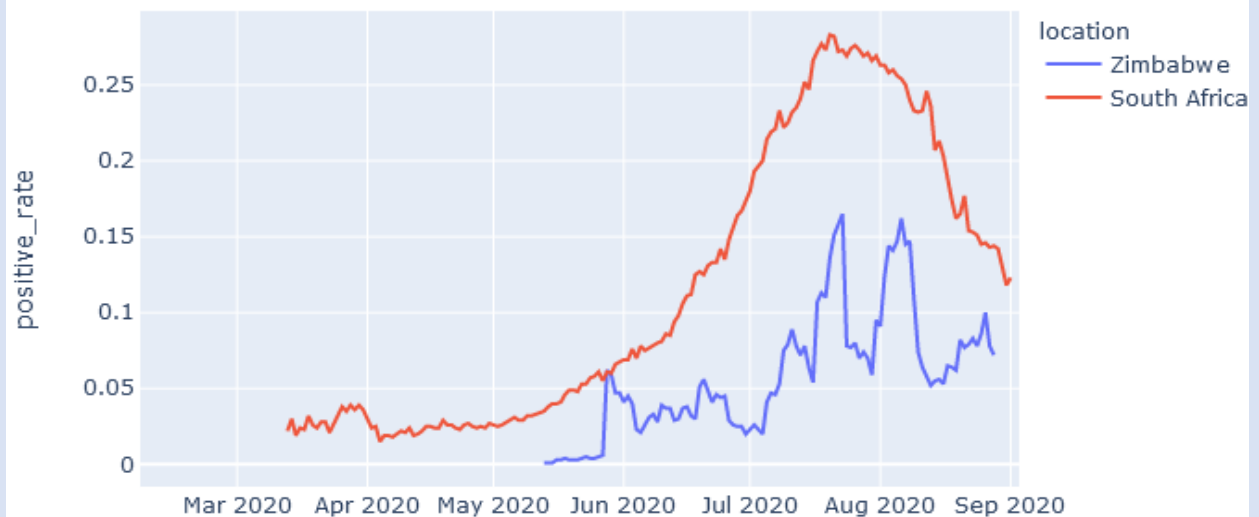

- **Overall Positivity has decreased to 7.2%**

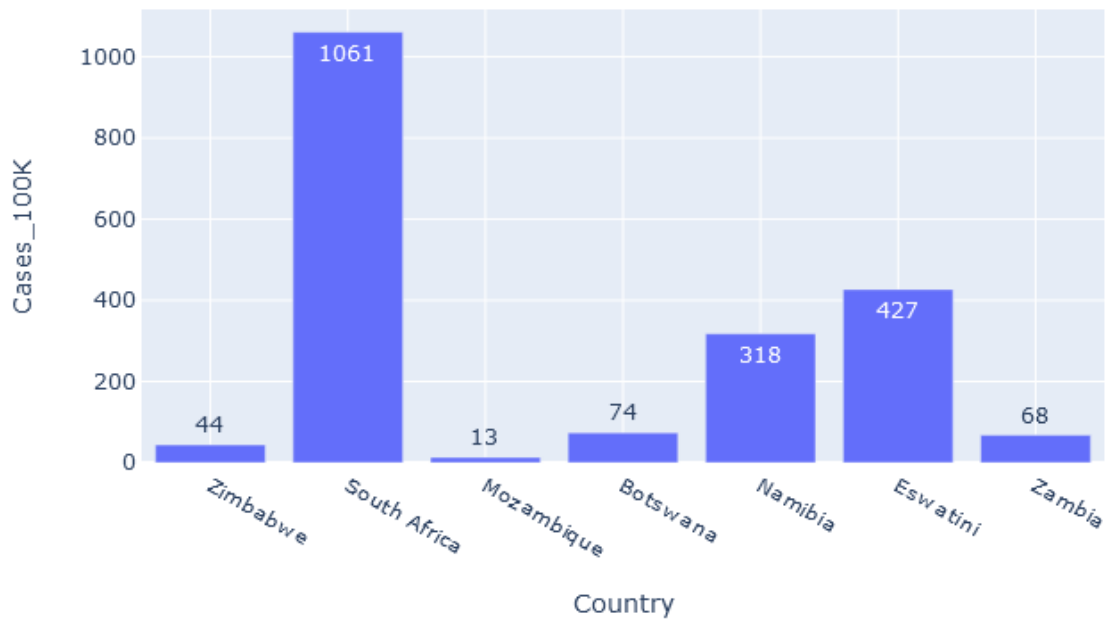

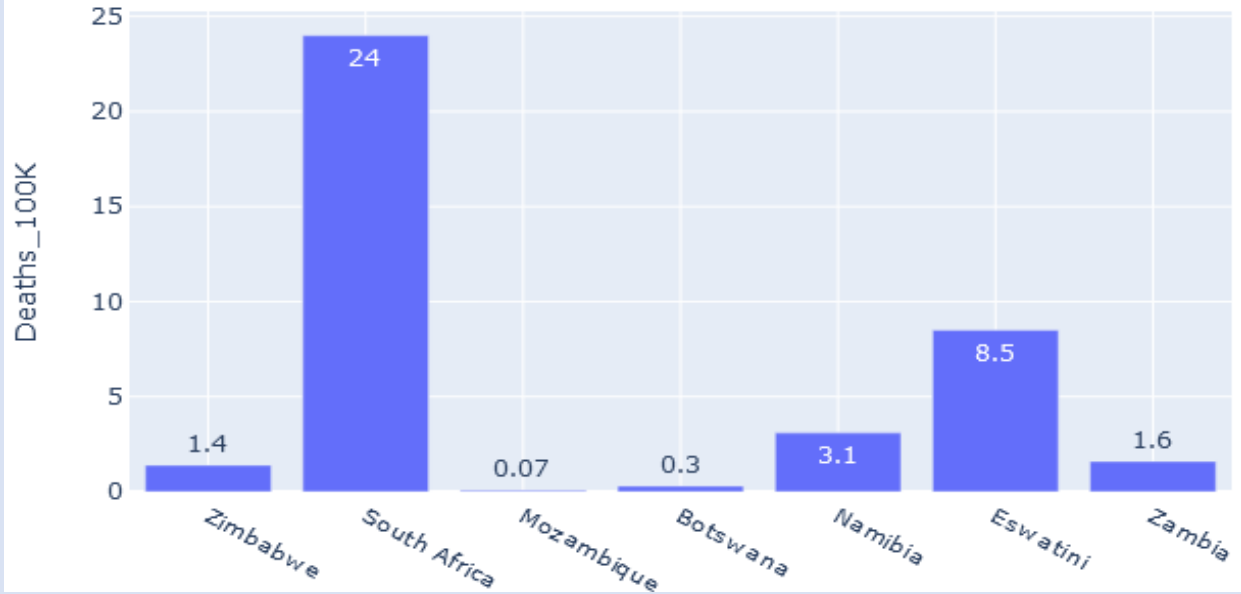
