



# Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 06/11/2020

# **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- 27 New Cases and 2 Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases rises to 16 from 14 yesterday).
- 756 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 3.6%)
- All 27 are local cases (Deaths reported by Bulawayo(1) and Mash East(1))
- 8 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 94.2% and Active cases go up to 238 today
- As of 6 November 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 8471 Cases 7983 recoveries and 250 Deaths.







### **COMMENTS**


#### **COMMENTS**

### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




### **COMMENTS**


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises






