



## Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 07/12/2020

## **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- 121 New Cases and 3 Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases rises to 115 from 109 yesterday).
- 1270 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 9.5%)
- All 121 are local cases(Deaths reported by Bulawayo, Harare and Masvingo)
- 92 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 82.8% and Active cases go up to 1573 today
- As of 07 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded 10839 Cases 8972 recoveries and 294 Deaths.

### **CASES AND DEATHS DISTRIBUTION**





## Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate




- Cumulative cases curve spiking

## Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




#### **COMMENTS**

**Age and Sex Distribution for Cases** 






### **COMMENTS**

## **COMMENTS**


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises







