

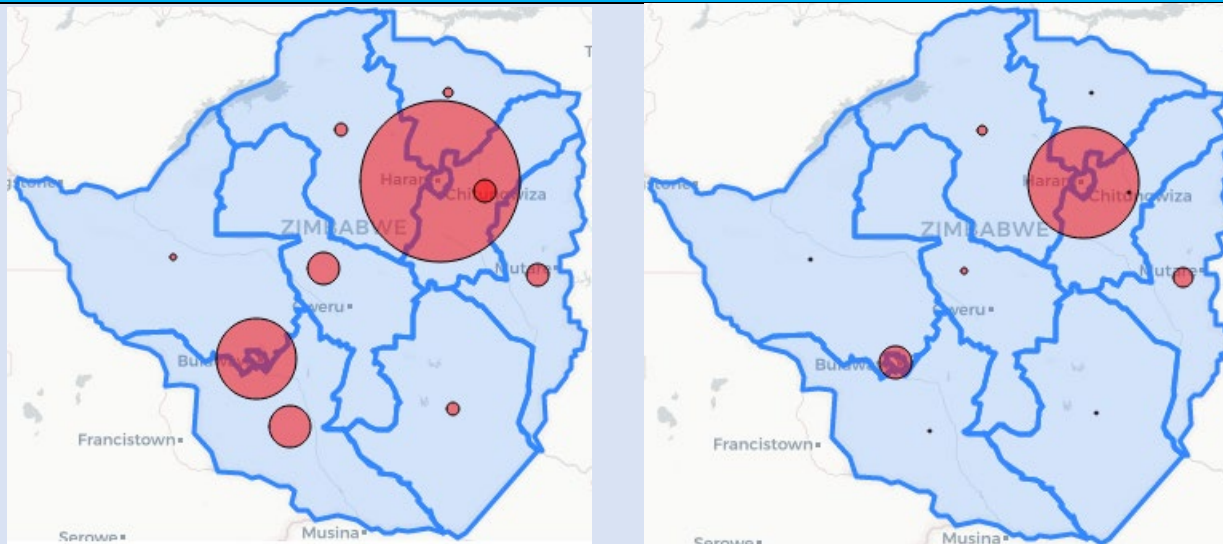


Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 08/12/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- **73** New Cases in the last 24 hours and **9*** Deaths reported retrospectively. (7 day rolling average* for new cases falls to **112** from **115** yesterday).
- **1965** PCR tests done today (Positivity today was **3.7%**)
- All **73** are local cases (All **9** Deaths reported by Harare retrospectively) *
- **90** new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at **83%** and Active cases go down to **1547** today
- As of 08 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded **10912** Cases **9062** recoveries and **303** Deaths.

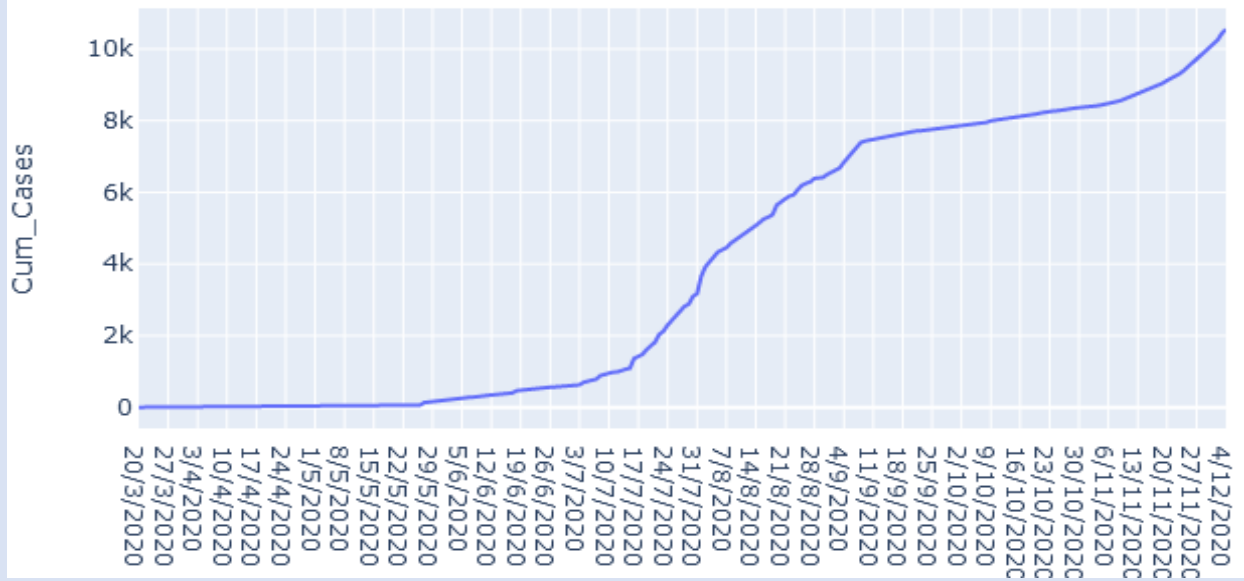

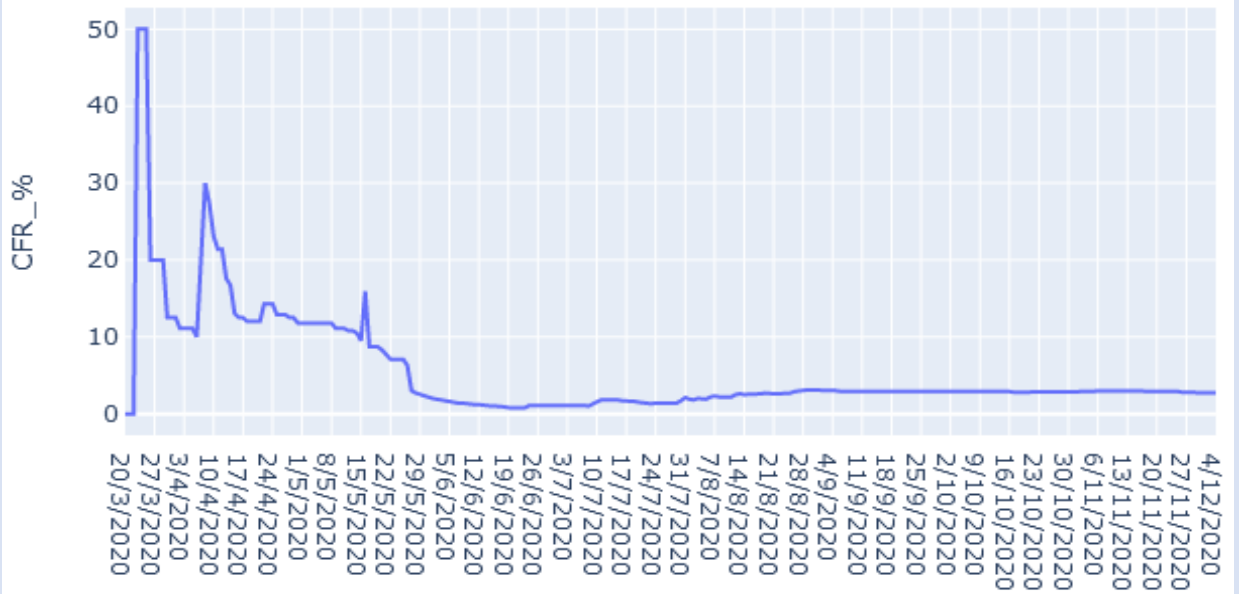

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



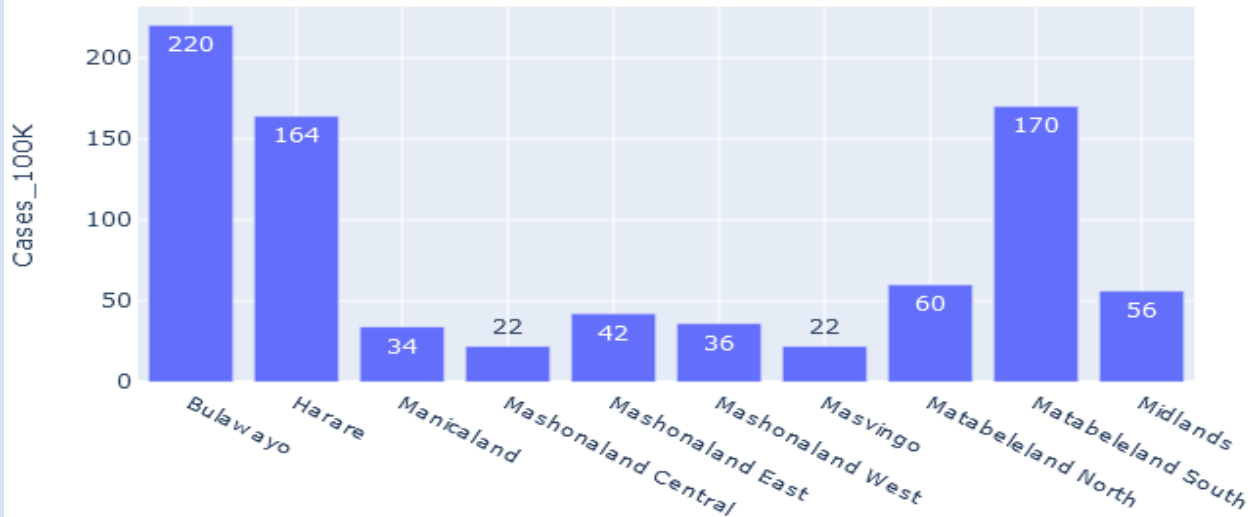

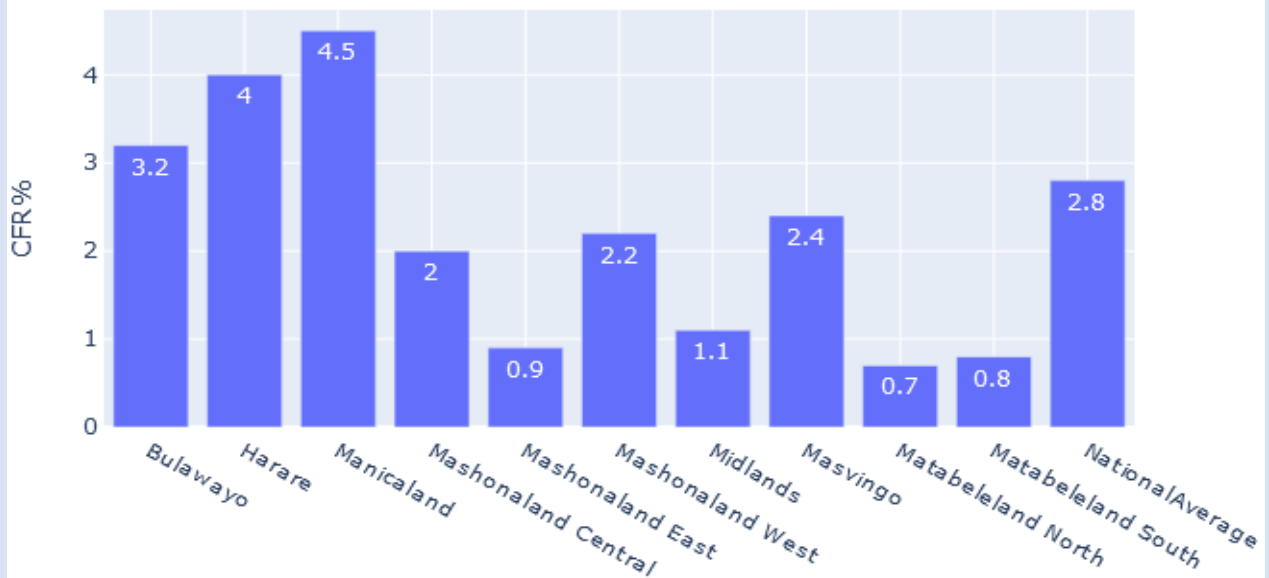
- Cumulative cases curve spiking

Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province



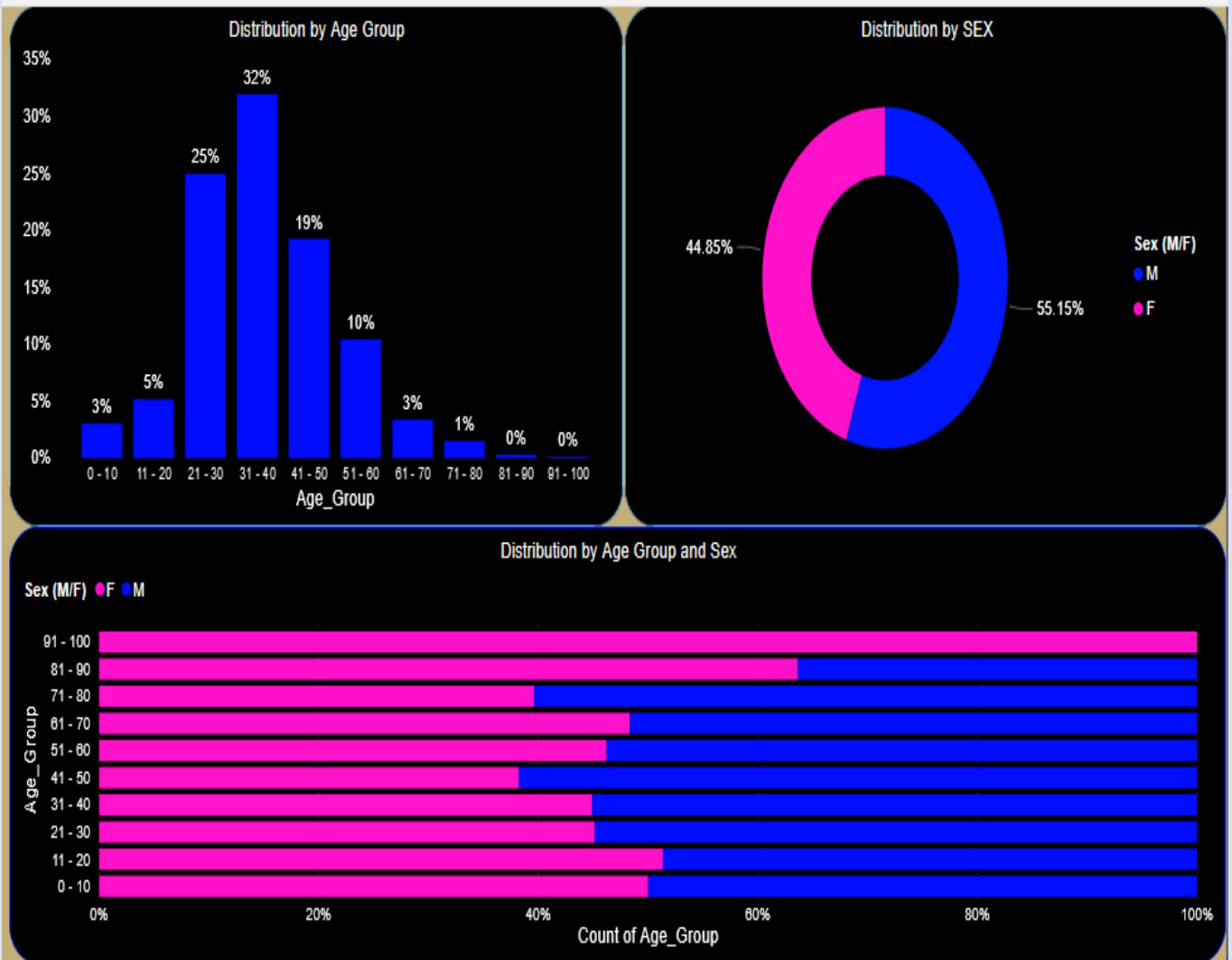
COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



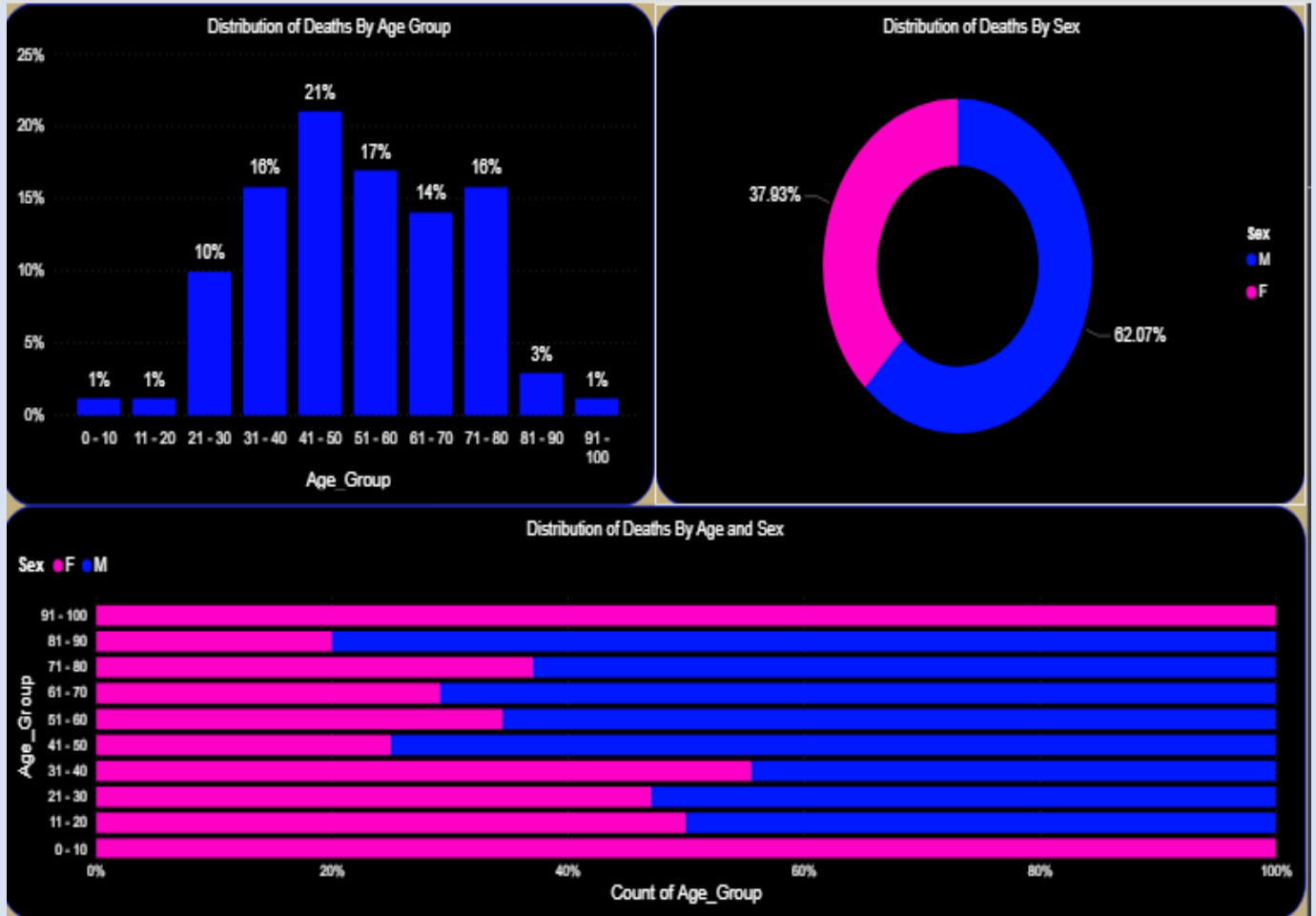
COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises

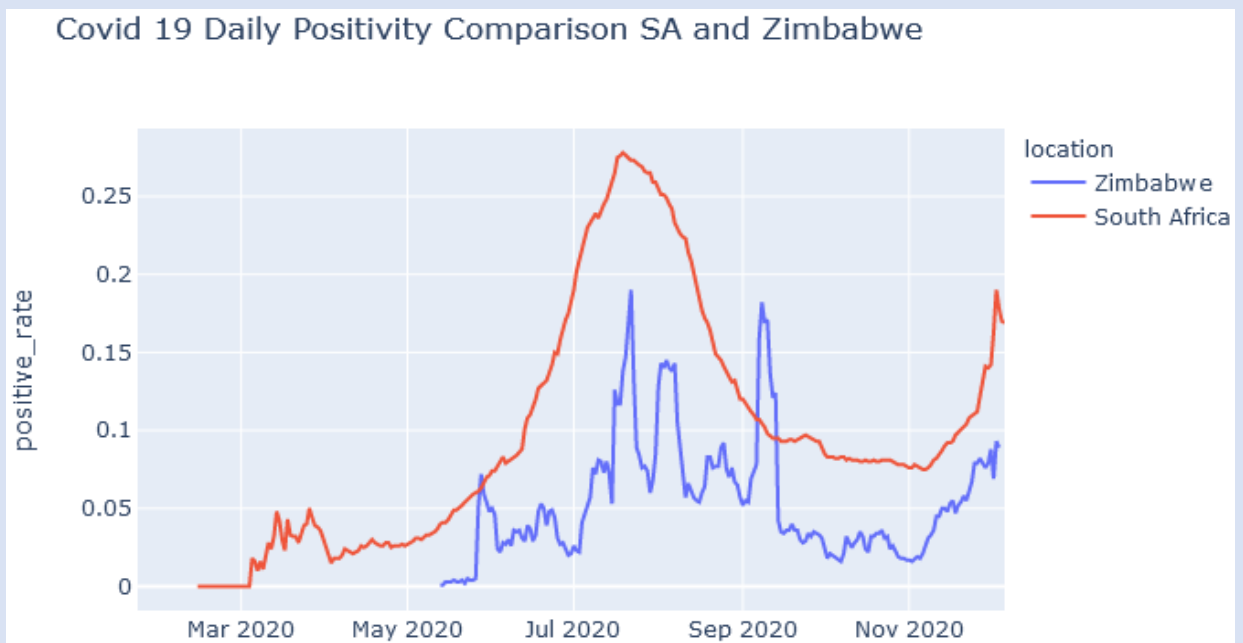
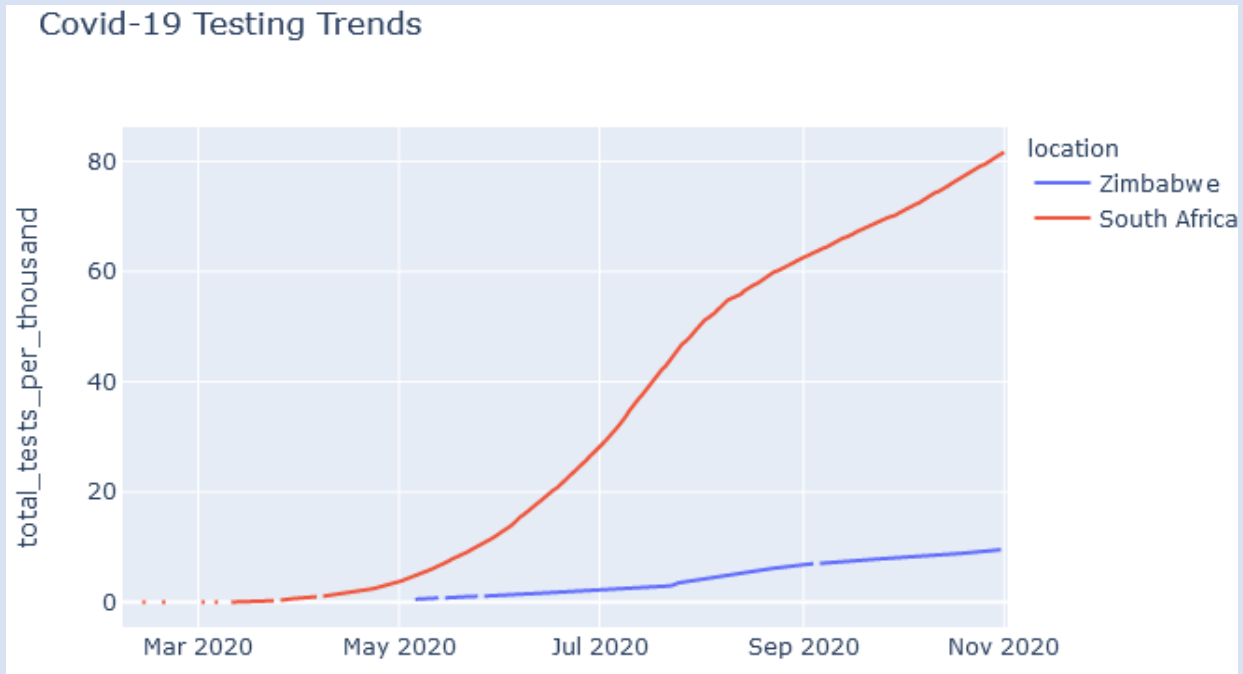

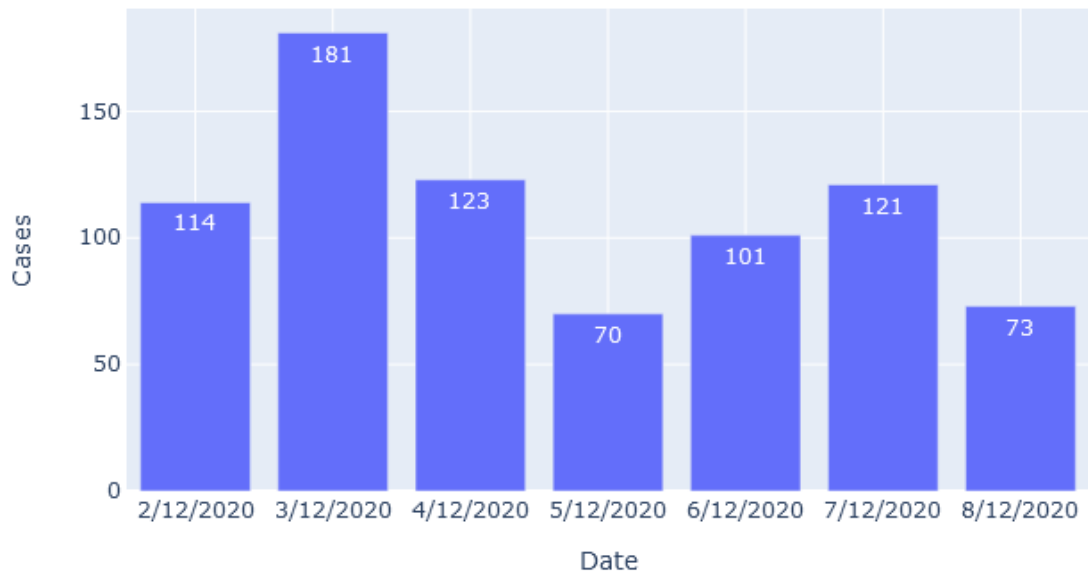

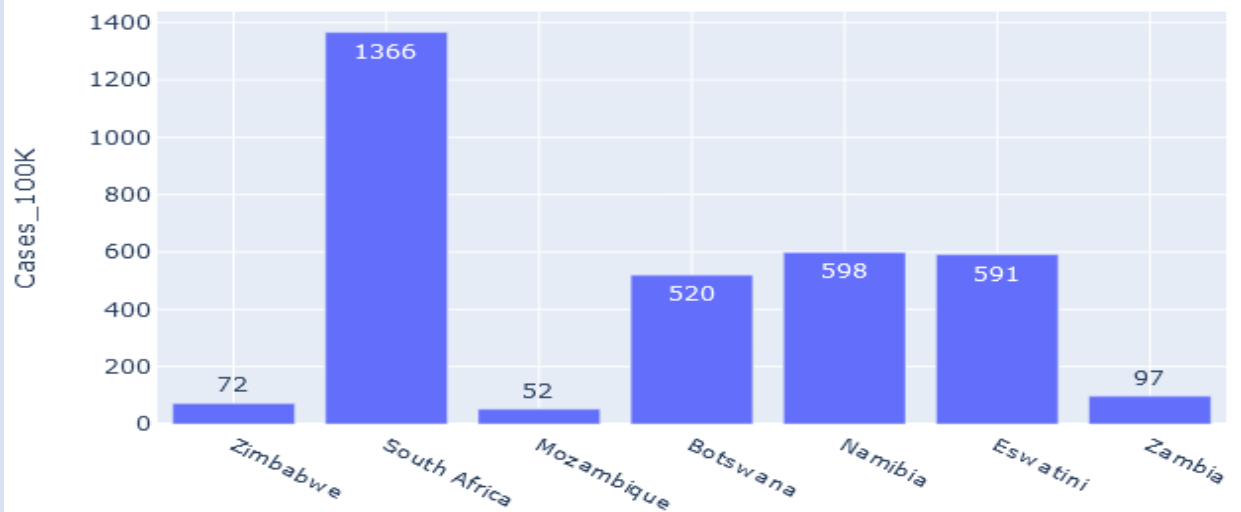

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cases In Last Seven Days

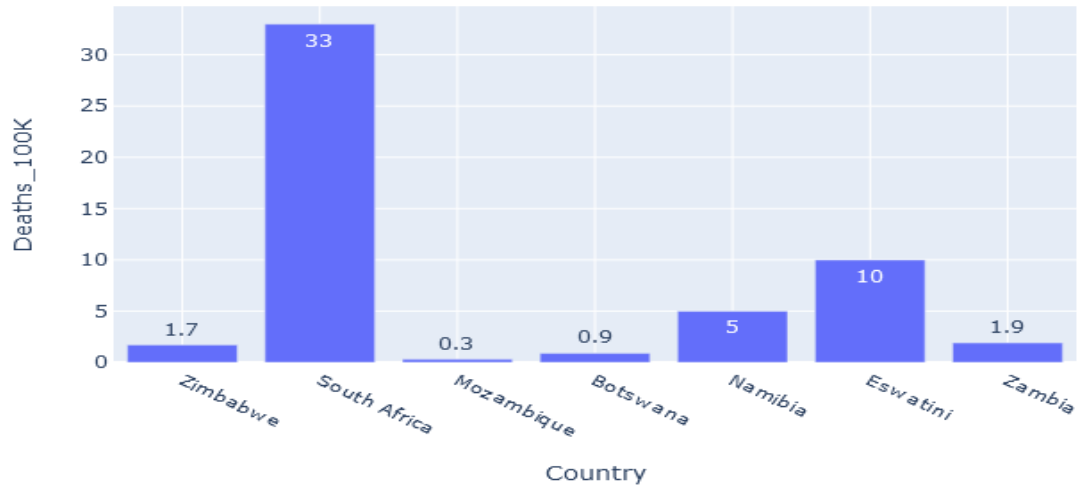


SADC Covid Cases Per 100K Population
