



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 08/12/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- **73** New Cases in the last 24 hours and 9* Deaths reported retrospectively. (7 day rolling average* for new cases falls to 112 from 115 yesterday).
- 1965 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 3.7%)
- All 73 are local cases (All 9 Deaths reported by Harare retrospectively) *
- 90 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 83% and Active cases go down to 1547 today
- As of 08 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded 10912 Cases 9062 recoveries and 303 Deaths.








- Cumulative cases curve spiking

Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises










Zimbabawe Covid-19 Cases In Last Seven Days
