



### Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 10/11/2020

### **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- 49 New Cases and 1 Death reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases rises to 29 from 25 yesterday).
- 1151 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 4.3%)
- 20 are local cases and 29 are returnees from SA (Death reported by Bulawayo)
- 17 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 93.4% and Active cases go up to 315 today
- As of 10 November 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 8610 Cases 8040 recoveries and 255 Deaths.










#### **COMMENTS**

### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




### **COMMENTS**


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises







- \*The Seven-Day Rolling average or moving average is used to take care of fluctuations in sample processing due by weekends or backlogs due to other operational issues. It is a mean of the last seven days' cases and it is calculated daily. It is used to highlight a finer trend of the variable being reported in this case New Covid-19 Cases in Zimbabwe.
- The Public is encouraged to keep following MOHCC prevention guidelines as a rise in cases has been noted with most cases reported by Bulawayo in the last two weeks
