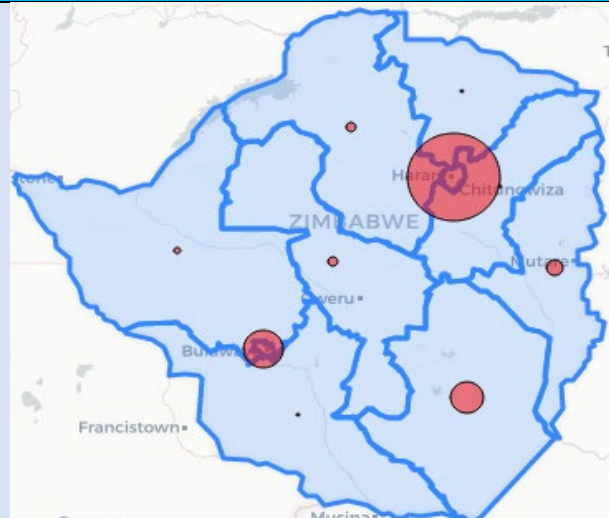
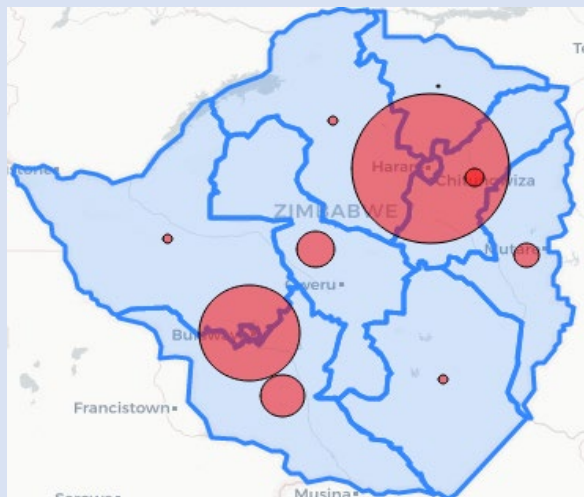

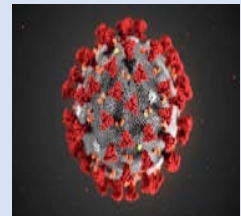
HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- As of 11 August 2020 Zimbabwe, has now recorded **4818** Cases and **104** Deaths

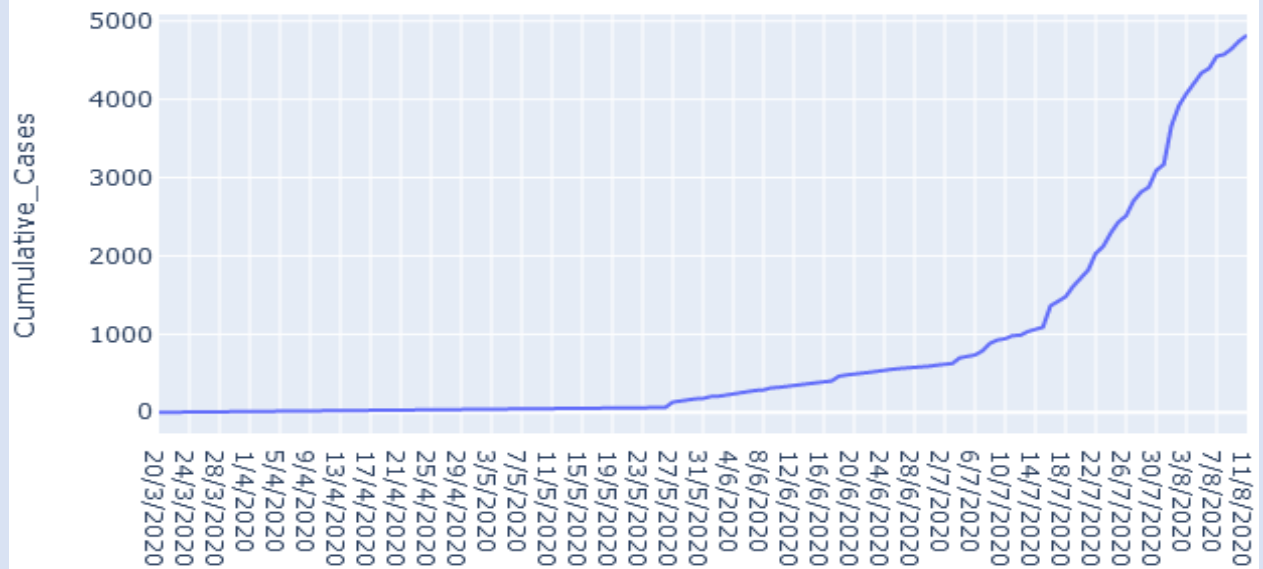

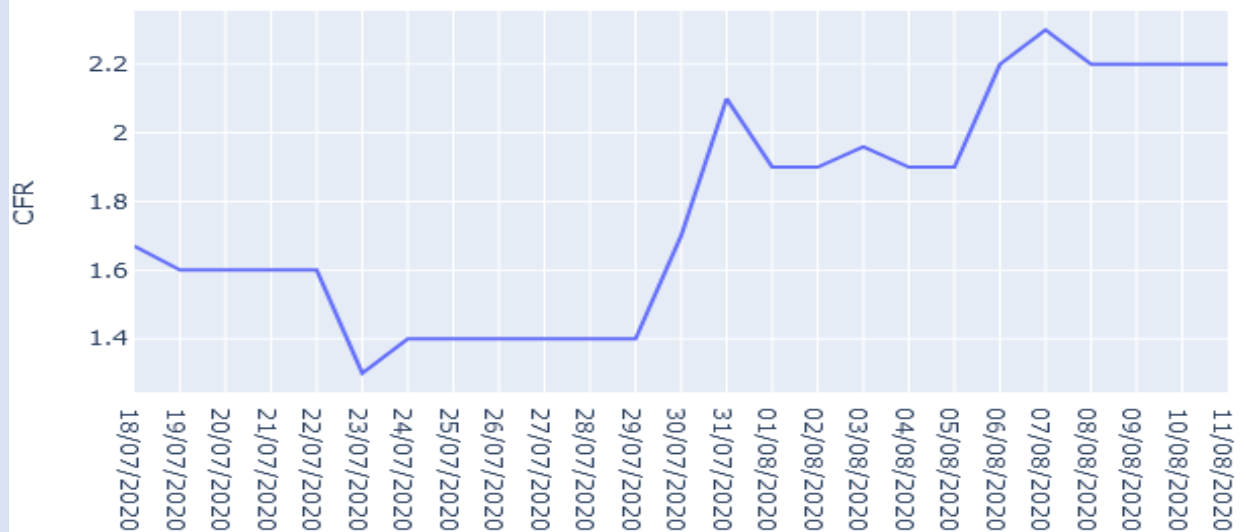

Zimbabwe Covid Timeseries Chart

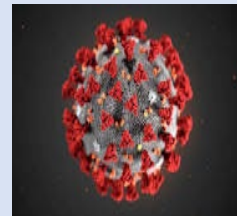


Zimbabwe Covid Case Fatality Rate Timeseries Chart



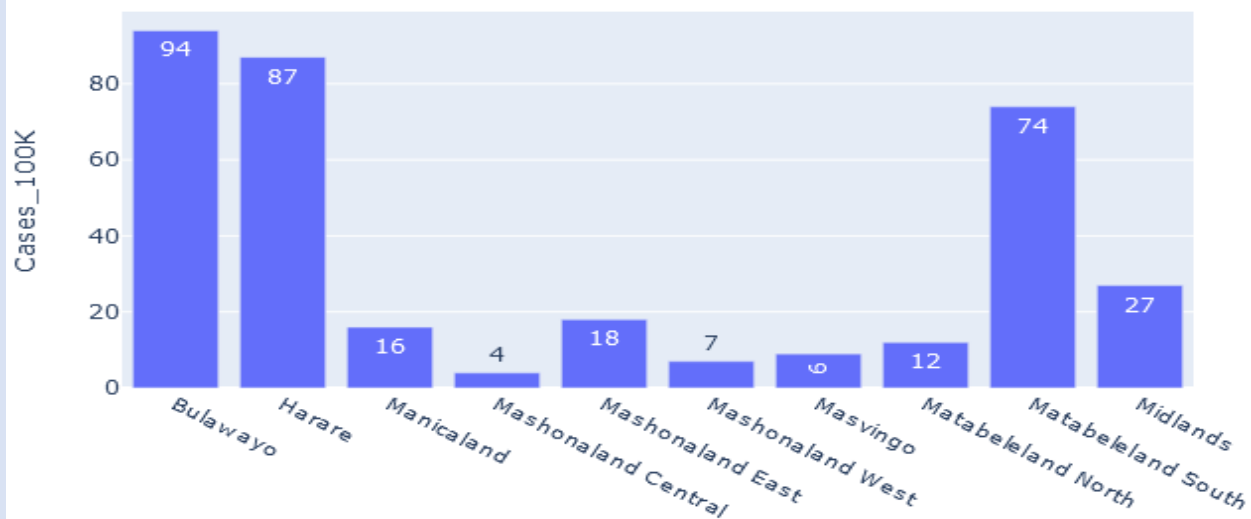
COMMENTS

- Case fatality rate has been rising and now stands at **2.2%** as at 11/8/20

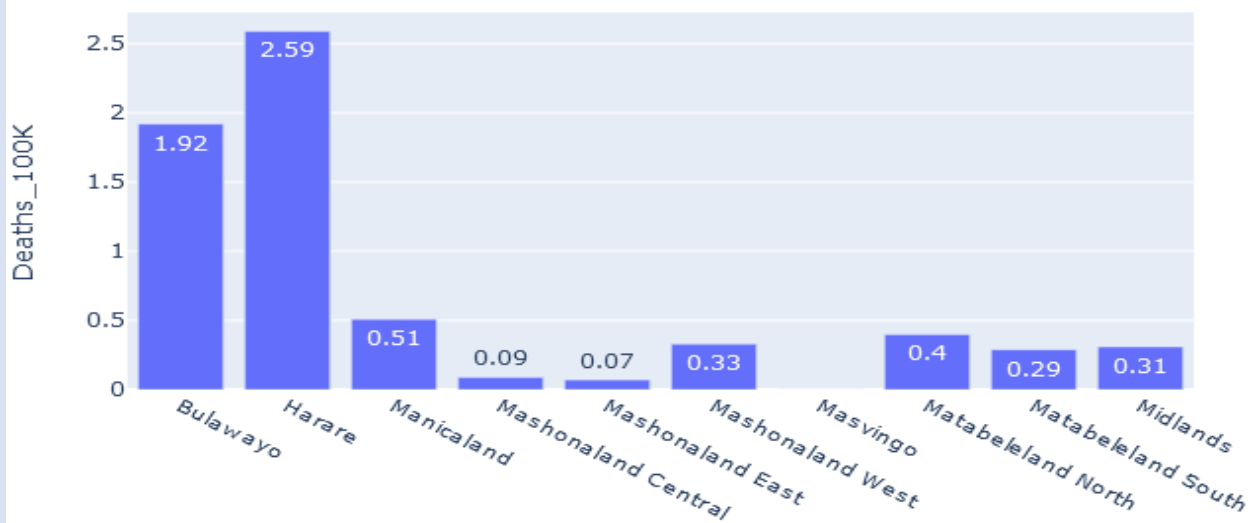

Zimbabwe Covid Cases Per 100K Popn

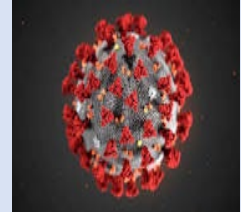


Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn



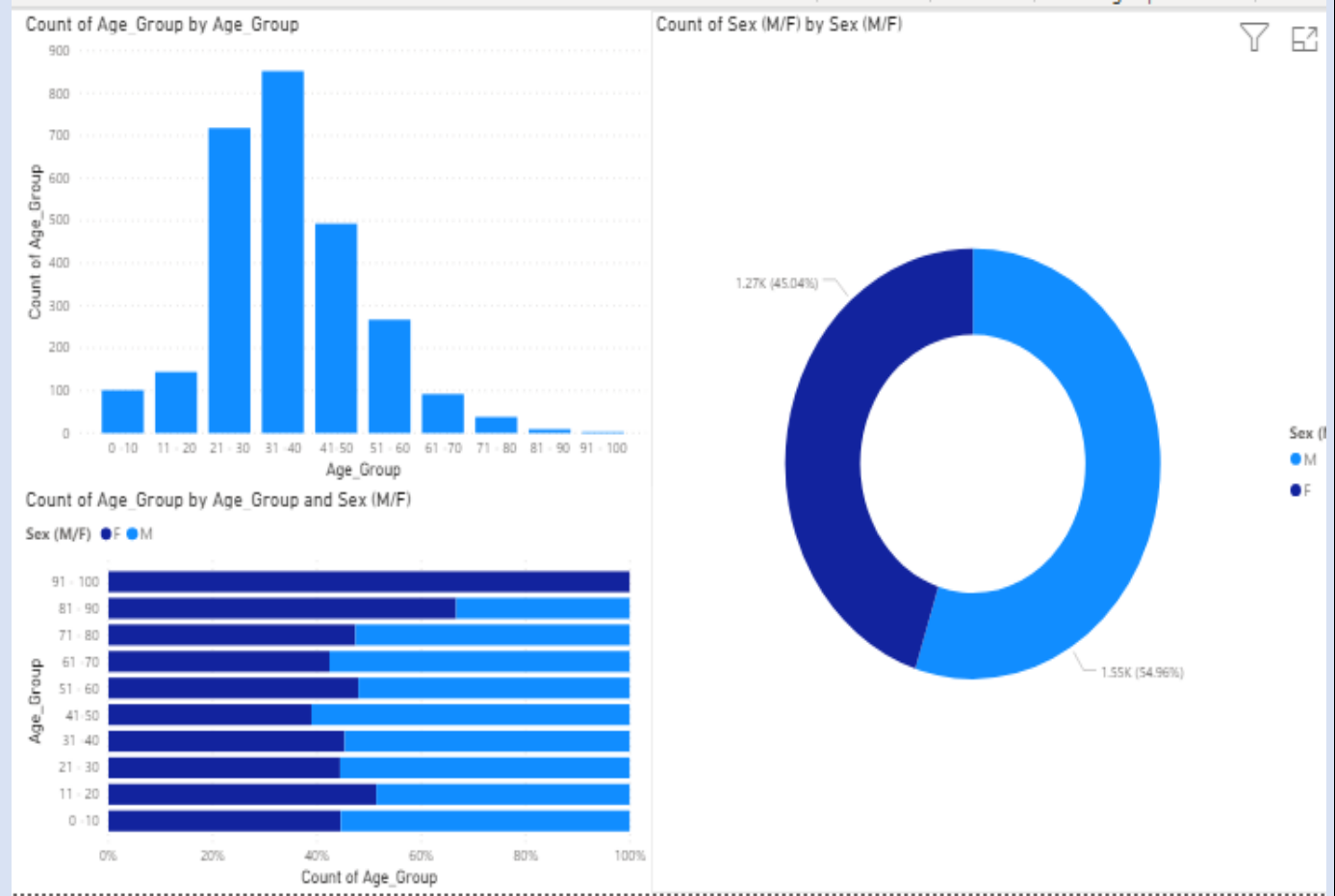
COMMENTS

- Harare has the highest number of deaths per capita followed by Bulawayo



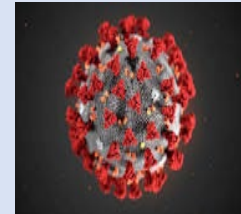
CHARACTERISTICS OF CASES

Age and Gender Distribution for Cases



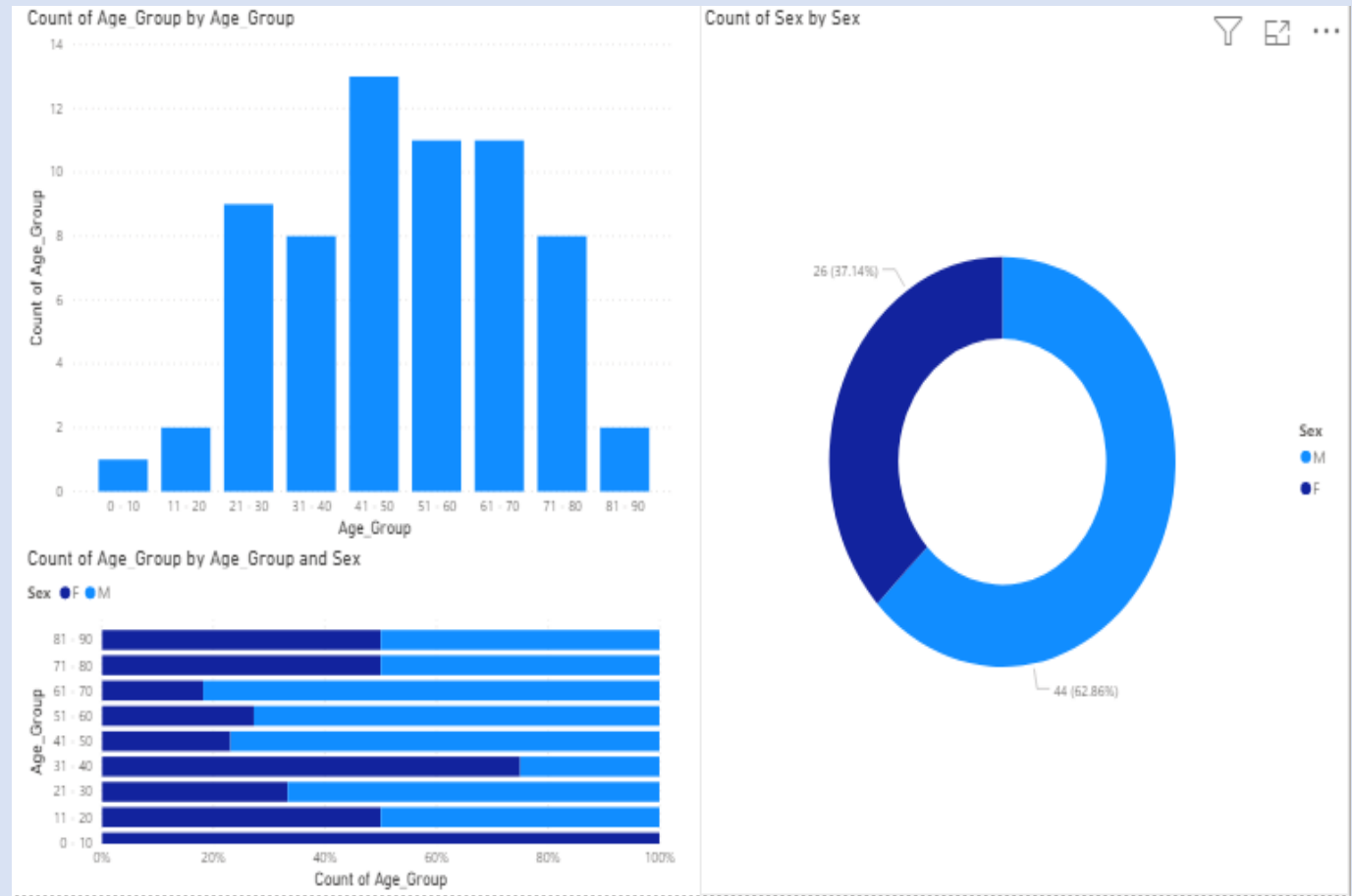
COMMENTS

Age and Gender Distribution of Deaths

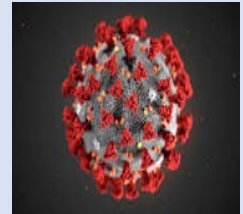

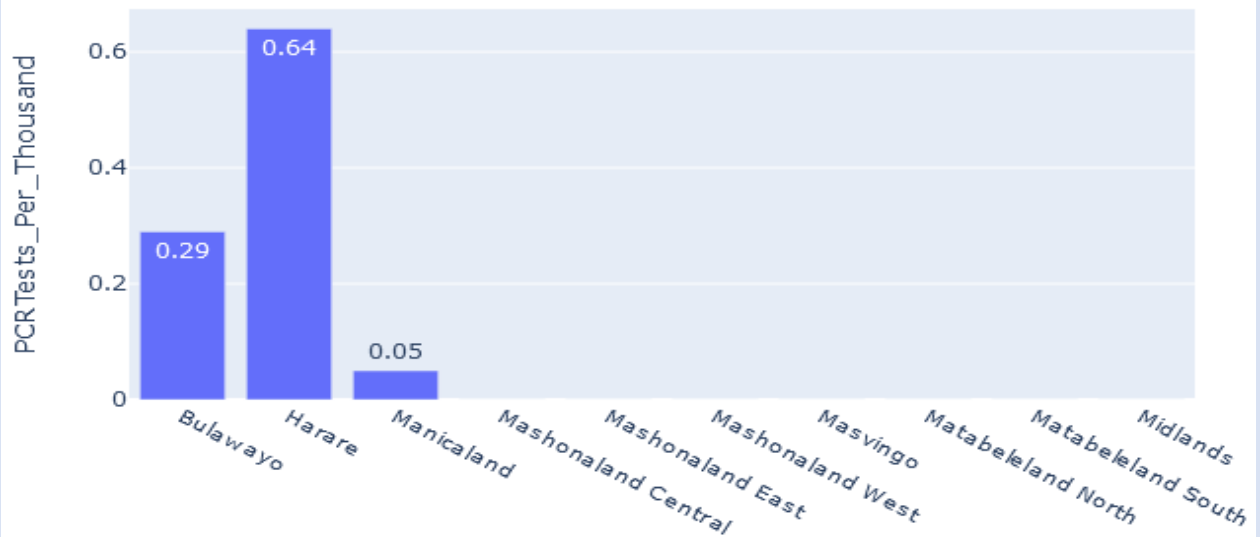
- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age

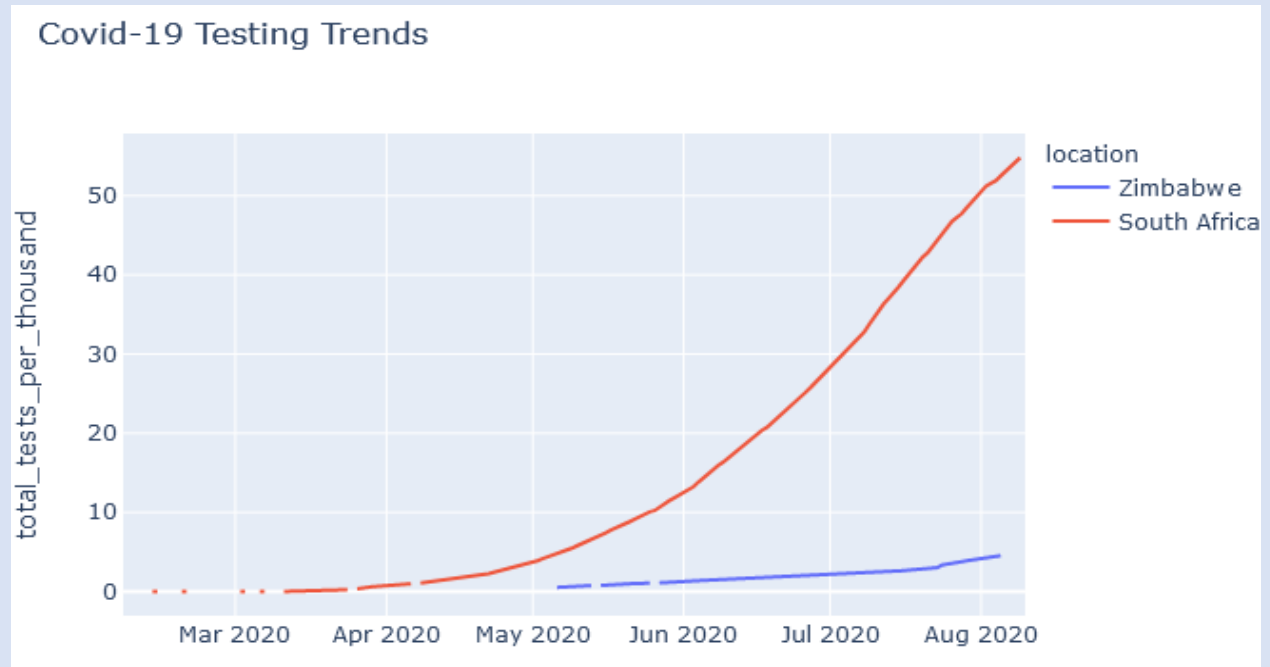

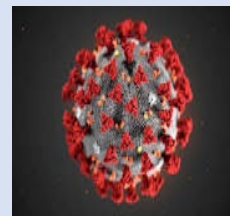


Number of PCR Tests done Per Thousand Population Today

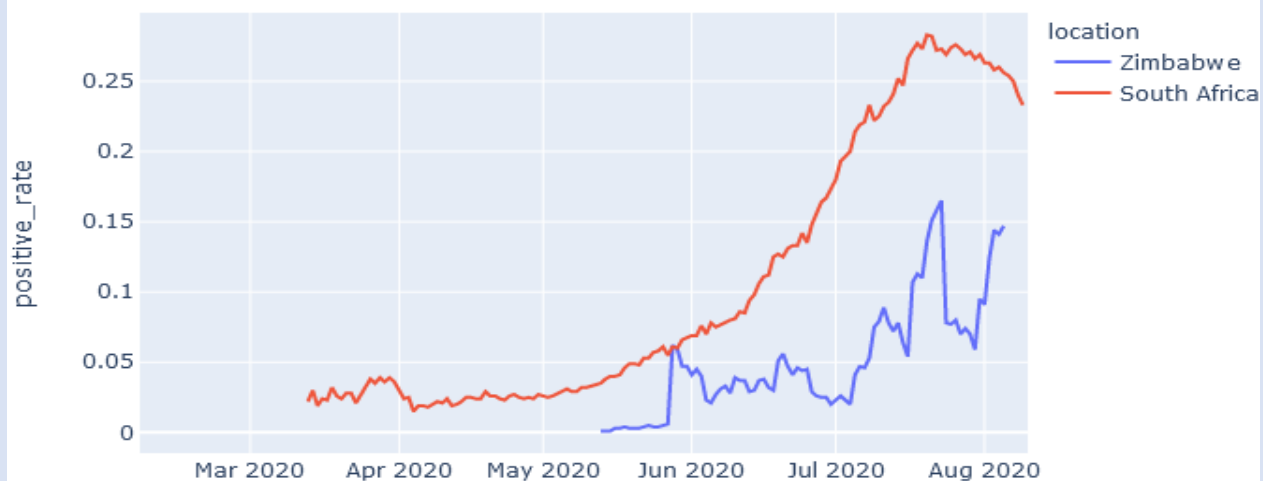

Covid-19 Positivity Rates



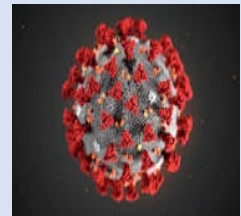
COMMENTS

- The trends show that when compared to South Africa Zimbabwe has been testing much less per capita

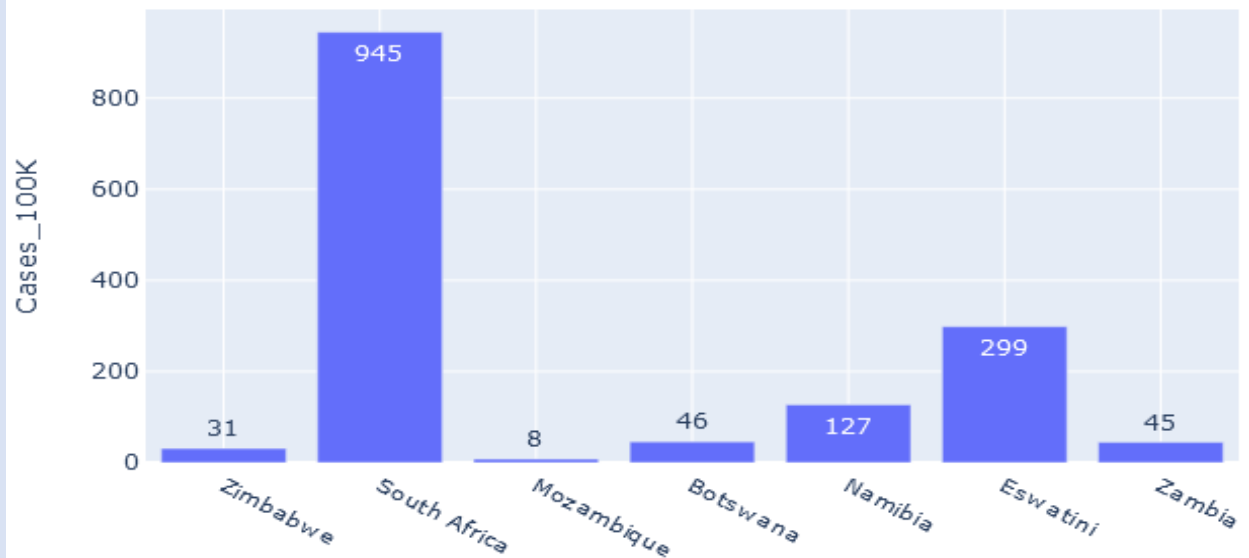

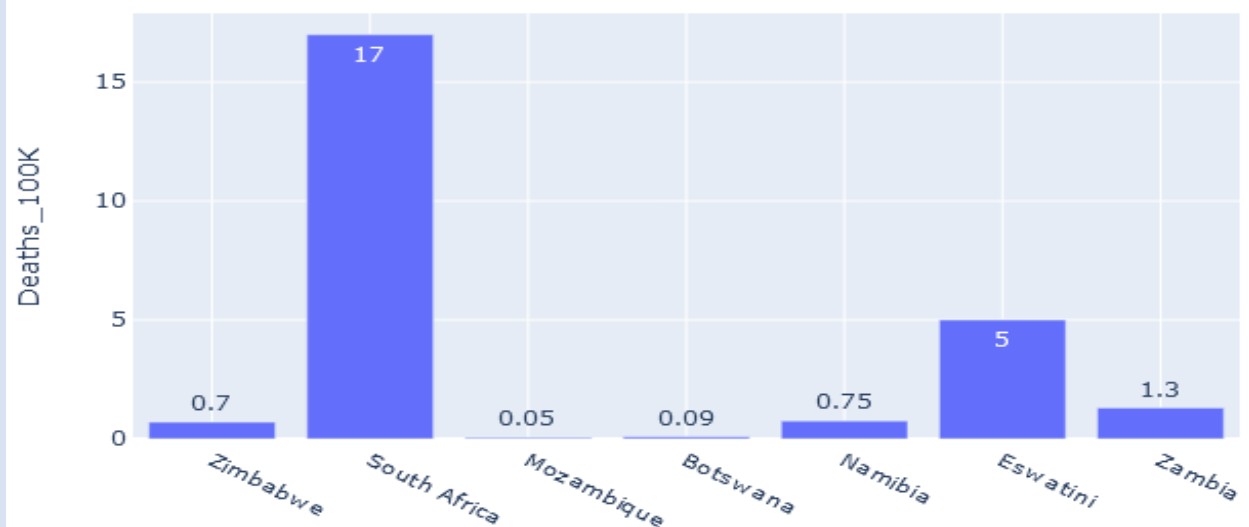
