



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 11/12/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 81 New Cases and 1 Death reported in the last 24 hours . (7 day rolling average* for new cases falls to 87 from 94 yesterday).
- 1444 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 5.6%)
- All 81 are local cases (1 Death reported by Manicaland)
- 64 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 83.5% and Active cases go up to 1532 today
- As of 11 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded **11162** Cases **9324** recoveries and **306** Deaths.





Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate





- National Case fatality Rate now stands at 2.7 % as at 11/12/20



Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases






- More males affected when compared to females


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)






