



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 11/11/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY


- 57 New Cases and No Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases rises to 34 from 29 yesterday).
- 613 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 9.3%)
- 33 are local cases and 24 are returnees from SA
- 6 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 92.8% and Active cases go up to 366 today
- As of 11 November 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 8667 Cases 8046 recoveries and 255 Deaths.





Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate





Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases






- More males affected when compared to females


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)




