





Zimbabwe MOHCC Covid-19 SitRep 13/08/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 97 New Cases and 6 Deaths reported in the last 24 hours
- All 97 are local cases
- Of the 6 deaths reported today 3 are from Manicaland
- Active Cases go down to 2935 today
- 307 new recoveries reported
- As of 13 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 4990 Cases and 128 Deaths


CASES AND DEATHS DISTRIBUTION










Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cumulative Cases


- Cumulative cases curve remains on an upward trend (approaches 5000 mark)
- Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at 2.56% as at 13/8/20






Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn


Age and Sex Distribution for Cases

Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths




COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises






- Harare had the highest number of tests done per capita today








SADC Covid Cases Per 100K Population
