



## Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 13/12/2020

## **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**

- 27 New Cases and No Deaths reported in the last 24 hours . (7 day rolling average\* for new cases falls to 75 from 86 yesterday).
- 1187 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 2.3%)
- All 27 are local cases
- 92 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 84% and Active cases go down to 1488 today
- As of 13 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded 11246 Cases 9451 recoveries and 307 Deaths.









- Cumulative cases curve spiking

## Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




#### **COMMENTS**

### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




### **COMMENTS**


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises







