

# **HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**


- 82 New Cases and NO Deaths reported in the last 24 hours
- All 82 are local cases
- Zimbabwe goes past 5000 cases
- Active Cases go up to 2946 today
- **71** new recoveries reported
- As of 14 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 5072 Cases and 128 Deaths










## Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cumulative Cases




## Zimbabwe Covid-19 Daily Case Fatality Rate


- Cumulative cases curve remains on an upward trend
- Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at 2.52% as at 14/8/20








### Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn

- Harare has the highest number of deaths per capita followed by Bulawayo




### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases


- More males affected when compared to females

### Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths




# **COMMENTS**

- There are more deaths from males as age rises








# Number of PCR Tests done Per Thousand Population Today


- Harare had the highest number of tests done per capita today
- The trends show that when compared to South Africa Zimbabwe has been testing much less per capita




