



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 15/11/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 43 New Cases and No Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases rises to 43 from 41 yesterday).
- 960 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 4.5%)
- All 43 are local cases
- No new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 91.7% and Active cases go up to 476 today
- As of 15 November 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 8829 Cases 8096 recoveries and 257 Deaths.









- Cumulative cases curve spiking

Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




COMMENTS


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises







- *The Seven-Day Rolling average or moving average is used to take care of fluctuations in sample processing due by weekends or backlogs due to other operational issues. It is a mean of the last seven days' cases and it is calculated daily. It is used to highlight a finer trend of the variable being reported in this case New Covid-19 Cases in Zimbabwe.
- The Public is encouraged to keep following MOHCC prevention guidelines as a rise in cases has been noted with most cases reported by Bulawayo in the last two weeks
