





Zimbabwe MOHCC Covid-19 SitRep 17/08/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 47 New Cases and 3 Deaths reported in the last 24 hours
- 42 are local cases and 5 are returnees from South Africa
- 1 Death is from Bulawayo Province, 1 from Mash East and the other from Manicaland
- Active Cases go down to 1325 today
- 1756 new recoveries reported (Harare reports 1698 recoveries)
- As of 17 August 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 5308 Cases 3848 recoveries and 135 Deaths


CASES AND DEATHS DISTRIBUTION










Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cumulative Cases


- · Cumulative cases curve remains on an upward trend
- Case fatality rate has now been rising again and now stands at 2.5% as at 17/8/20






Zimbabwe Covid Deaths Per 100K Popn


Age and Sex Distribution for Cases


- More males affected when compared to females

Age and Sex Distribution of Deaths




COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises




- Harare had the highest number of tests done per capita today












SADC Covid Deaths Per 100K Population
