



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 18/11/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 36 New Cases and 1 Death reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases falls to 45 from 48 yesterday).
- 1246 PCR tests done today (Positivity today was 2.9%)
- All 36 are local cases (Death reported by Masvingo)
- 20 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 91.3% and Active cases go up to 536 today
- As of 18 November 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 8981 Cases 8184 recoveries and 261 Deaths.

CASES AND DEATHS DISTRIBUTION





Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate




- Cumulative cases curve spiking


COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




COMMENTS


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises







- *The Seven-Day Rolling average or moving average is used to take care of fluctuations in sample processing due by weekends or backlogs due to other operational issues. It is a mean of the last seven days' cases and it is calculated daily. It is used to highlight a finer trend of the variable being reported in this case New Covid-19 Cases in Zimbabwe.
- The Public is encouraged to keep following MOHCC prevention guidelines as a rise in cases has been noted with most cases reported by Bulawayo in the last two weeks
