



Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 18/09/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- 14 New Cases and No Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases further goes down to 24 from 26 yesterday).
- 755 PCR tests done today (positivity for today was 1.9%)
- All 14 are local cases
- 42 total new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 77% and Active cases go down to 1535 today
- As of 18 September 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded 7647 Cases 5883 recoveries and 224 Deaths.






- Cumulative cases curve remains on an upward trend

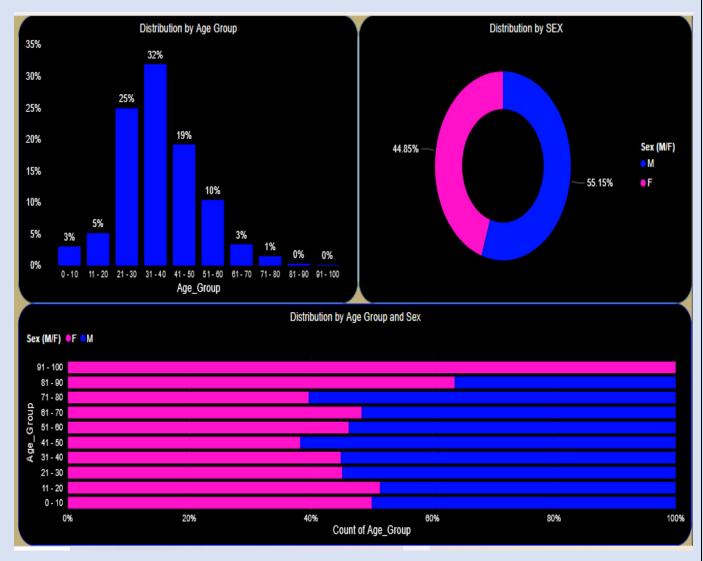
COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



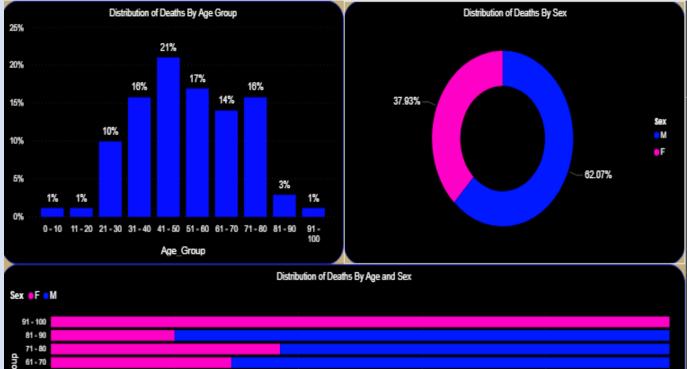


- More males affected when compared to females


- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises






